Partners in the Gospel is a strategic pastoral planning effort taking place across the Archdiocese of Seattle to re-

invigorate and renew our local Catholic Church.

In this process the pastor, parish leaders and parishioners will determine how new faith families will best join together to carry out the mission of the Church in each locality. There is no predetermined outcome for this strategic pastoral planning effort. The outcomes will differ by parish family, but some changes might include a new pastor and parochial vicar, changes to Mass times and locations, and new outreach ministry opportunities. While the possibly of parish closings may exist it is the parish leadership, with input from parishioners and guidance from the Holy Spirit, who will make decisions about how to best carry out their mission locally.

FIRST COMMUNION Sunday, May 7, 11:00 am Mass


