### Misleading Finals

**Central Michigan (-2.5) beat Buffalo 38-19.** However Buffalo had a 398-388 yard edge but the Bulls were -3 in turnovers. CMU got a 85-yard fumble return TD and a 48-yard interception return TD.

**Clemson (+1.5) upset Louisville 20-19.** However, Louisville had a 385-308 yard edge. The Cardinals missed two field goals and an extra point.

**Connecticut (-7.5) beat Air Force 26-16.** However, Air Force had a 356-347 yard edge. AF was stopped on downs at the UConn 3-yard line and missed a FG.

**Oklahoma (+6.5) upset Alabama 23-21.** However, Alabama had a 406-212 yard edge. The Sooners were +3 in turnovers including a 87-yard "Pick 6".

**Kansas State (-20) beat Oklahoma State 14-6.** However, Oklahoma State had a 373-284 yard edge. Kansas State was +4 in turnovers. Oklahoma State fumbled at the Kansas State 23-yard line and were intercepted at the K-State 30.

**Utah (-9.5) crushed Baylor 55-28.** However, Baylor had a 563-483 yard edge. Utah got a 65-yard "Pick 6." Baylor missed a FG and were stopped on downs three times in Utah territory.

**LSU (-4.5) beat Arkansas 23-22.** However, Arkansas fumbled at the LSU 24-yard line, were intercepted at the LSU 9-yard line, stopped on downs at the LSU 1-yard line and missed a FG.

**Michigan (-10) beat Northwestern 24-22.** It should have been much worse. Michigan had a 496-245 yard edge but were -5 in turnovers and missed two FG's.

**Jacksonville State (+3.5) upset Kennesaw State 35-26.** However, Kennesaw State had a 579-451 yard edge but were -4 in turnovers.

**Arizona State (-10) beat West Virginia 25-23.** However, West Virginia had a 421-330 yard. WVU was stopped on downs at the ASU 6-yard line and 2-yard line.

### Bad Beats

**UNLV (-4.5) beat Utah State 29-26 in double overtime.** Utah State was +168 on the money-line but missed three field goals and an extra point.

**The total in the North Carolina/Wake Forest game was 37.5.** Wake scored a TD on 4th Down and goal with :22 left to win 28-12. The game would have ended but Bill Belichick called timeout with the clock running prior to the 4th Down.

## Games in Rotation Order

## HOME TEAM IN CAPS

### Wednesday, November 19th

**Miami, OH 21 BUFFALO 20.** Both teams are +0.6 in ypp margin but Miami has played the tougher schedule (No. 93 vs No. 144). Miami starting QB Dequan Finn quit the team last week and Hesson the backup was only 11 of 38 for 147 yards and 3 interceptions in the 24-3 loss vs Toledo. Buffalo had a misleading 38-19 loss to CMU where CMU scored a couple of defensive TD's. Miami has gone from 2-point underdog to 2.5-point favorite. We lean Buffalo at current.

**Central Michigan 28 KENT STATE 20.** Kent State still has a shot at bowl eligibility. Yes, that Kent State team who's season win total was 1.5. It will be a tall order here vs a CMU team that is on a 6-1 ATS run and is thinking MAC Championship still.

### Thursday, November 20th

**ARKANSAS STATE 27 UL-Lafayette 26.** ULL has the better ypp margin (-0.6 vs -1.2) despite playing a tougher schedule (No. 89 vs No. 96). ULL is also the better running team (No. 35 vs No. 97) and has the slightly better defense. We bet ULL +3.5 and so far the market agrees. Totals players note the UNDER has cashed in 8 straight Arkansas State games by an average of 11.8 points per game.

### Friday, November 21st

**Florida State 33 NC STATE 27.** FSU is just 5-5 on the season. Their stats tell a different story as they are No. 10 in ypp margin (+1.9), No. 9 in ypg margin (+165.5) and No. 14 in scoring margin (+16.1). The matchup to watch here is a FSU offense that ranks No. 7 taking on a NC State defense that ranks No. 127.

**UNLV 33 Hawaii 31.** We really like the spot here for Hawaii coming off a bye. They're taking on a UNLV team playing on a short week after going to two overtimes vs Utah State last week. The Rebels should have lost the game as the Aggies missed three field goals and an extra point. The Warriors have pulled four outright upsets already this season and we wouldn't be surprised if they pulled another here.

### Saturday, November 22nd

**OHIO STATE 40 Rutgers 10.** How much motivation does Ohio State have here? They got "THE GAME" on deck at Michigan and a likely meeting vs 12-0 Indiana after that. Meanwhile, Rutgers comes in off a bye. Does Ohio State rest WR's Jeremiah Smith and Carnell Tate? If that's the case, we think Rutgers is worth a look at "+31.5" as the Scarlet Knights poor defense won't be too exposed.

**Connecticut 36 FLORIDA ATLANTIC 29.** Jim Mora Jr is not getting enough credit for what he's doing in Connecticut. The Huskies are 8-3 and all three losses came in OT. That's one year after a 9-4 season. FAU still has bowl hopes and have covered five of six. We haven't bet side or total.

**Tulane 32 TEMPLE 23.** Temple needs one more win to get to bowl eligibility and come in off a bye. The CFB Playoff committee really likes Tulane as they ranked the Green Wave No. 24 in the latest playoff rankings. We did bet Tulane on Sunday and so far the market agrees.

**Marshall 31 APPALACHIAN STATE 28.** Marshall needs one more win for bowl eligibility. App State needs two. Even after their 58-10 loss to James Madison last week, the Mountaineers have a better ypp margin (-0.3 vs -0.5) than Marshall. We lean with them but prefer the OVER which is 7-3 in Marshall games by an average of 10.0 ppg.

**ARMY 28 Tulsa 18.** Army comes in off a bye. Meanwhile, Tulsa comes in off the huge win vs Oregon State. The Golden Hurricane have the better ypp margin (-0.5 vs -0.7) but Army has played the tougher schedule (No. 72 vs No. 98) and has the situational edge.

**CENTRAL FLORIDA 34 Oklahoma State 17.** You can make a case that Oklahoma St played by far their best game of the season last week. They outgained Kansas State by nearly 100 yards but were done in by a -4 turnover margin in the 14-6 loss as 20-point underdogs. They're taking on a UCF team that is reeling off a blowout loss to Texas Tech. Our numbers say UCF is the play here despite the recent results.

**Old Dominion 36 GEORGIA SOUTHERN 25.** Georgia Southern needs one more win for bowl eligibility. While ODU can't make the Sun Belt Championship, they are positioning themselves for a better bowl. They have extra time to prep after crushing Troy on Thursday night. The Monarchs rank No. 7 in ypp margin at +2.1. We bet them on Sunday but can't recommend them at current.

**WAKE FOREST 34 Delaware 17.** Delaware lost outright as 12-point favorites last week to Sam Houston State. The Blue Hens have now only covered once in their last six games. Wake is coming off back-to-back wins and still has a shot at a 10-win season. Their defense ranks No. 10 allowing only 4.5 yards per play. The problem is we're not wild about laying 17.5 with an offense that averages just 23.8 ppg.

**Byu 28 CINCINNATI 26.** BYU rebounded nicely off their first loss of the season by crushing TCU 44-13. The market had their doubts as BYU only closed a 3-point favorite. They're taking on a Cincinnati team that had a disappointing upset loss at home to Arizona last week. The good news is Cincy could get back a couple of their top playmakers here. At current, we don't see much value.

**Tennessee 31 FLORIDA 27.** The Vols have won two of the last 3 meetings but both of them have come in Knoxville. Tennessee is 0-10 straight up and 2-8 ATS in their last 10 trips to the Swamp. Obviously, it's not a great Florida team this year as the Gators are 3-7 and playing with an interim. They did lead Ole Miss at the half last week and we don't expect them to quit here.

**JAMES MADISON 29 Washington State 17.** James Madison is racking up the style points and they got another blowout win last week. This time over Appalachian State 58-10. The Monarchs have covered their games (7-3 ATS) by an average of 9.3 points per game this year. They rank in the Top 8 in ypp margin, ypg margin and scoring margin nationally. Very long trip for Washington State who did only suffer 3-point and 2-point losses to Ole Miss and Virginia on the road. We lean OVER despite both teams playing a slow tempo.

**GEORGIA TECH 32 Pittsburgh 28.** Both teams have everything to play for here. A win sends Georgia Tech to the ACC Championship game. Pitt can get their by winning their final two (no easy task as they host Miami next week). The Panthers had ESPN College Gameday on hand last week. They were embarrassed by Notre Dame. GT had to rally from 11 down in the fourth quarter to beat Boston College. The Yellow Jackets have the No. 1 offense in the country in ypp and ypg. We trust them at home and with the better staff.

**Michigan 30 MARYLAND 16.** Maryland had lost six straight games but the AD announced Mike Locksley will return next season. Michigan is coming off a 5-point win over Purdue and a 2-point win over Northwestern in their last two outings. Tough trusting them to lay a lot of points as they don't have a great passing game and don't run a ton of tempo. However, we bet them on Sunday and so far the market agrees.

**Duke 27 NORTH CAROLINA 22.** It's not Coach K vs Roy Williams but Bill Belichick vs Manny Diaz does have some interesting story-lines. Is Bill "one and done" at Chapel Hill. The Heels are playing better as of late but are still just 4-6. Duke is off a horrific loss at home to Virginia where they got pounded from start to finish. That eliminated them from ACC title talk. We bet NC at open and also lean UNDER.

**TOLEDO 35 Ball State 10.** Toledo is easily the best team in the MAC and this point spread reflects that. The Rockets rank No. 4 in the country at +2.4 yards per play, No. 6 at +193.2 ypg and No. 10 in scoring margin at +18.6. Their No. 1 defense in ypp allowed should feast vs a Ball State offense that ranks No. 134 in offensive ypp.

**PENN STATE 28 Nebraska 18.** You can make a case that Penn State is playing much better under interim coach Terry Smith. The Nittany Lions were 0-6 ATS under Franklin but have covered 3 of 4 under Smith. They ended their 6-game losing streak straight up by handling Michigan State 28-10 last week. Nebraska is off a bye. The Huskers are better in ypp margin (+1.1 vs +0.3) but have played an easier schedule (No. 61 vs No. 24). This is a lay 9.5, take 10.5 type of game.

**Miami, FL 33 VIRGINIA TECH 16.** Miami looked like they were going for style points last week. We think they played their best game of the season as they outgained NC State 581-143 in the 34-point win. While the committee has them ranked as the highest ACC team, the Hurricanes are long-shots to make the ACC title game. Now they're taking on a VT team that should have a solid home atmosphere after announcing James Franklin as the next coach.

**SOUTH CAROLINA 38 Coastal Carolina 14.** Coastal Carolina QB Samari Collier is likely out for this game. It will be interesting to see what frame of mind South Carolina will be in after blowing a 30-3 halftime lead vs Texas A&M last week. The Gamecocks already fired their OC...we think Beamer should be on the chopping block too although he'll likely get another year. Huge strength of schedule disparity (No. 2 vs No. 114).

**OKLAHOMA 27 Missouri 18.** Oklahoma is off one of their biggest wins in recent memory. Not only because they upset Alabama on the road, but it also got them into the playoffs if they take care of business here and next week (host LSU). OU's season win total was only 6.5 so it'd be an incredible season for Venables. Missouri announced that QB Beau Pribula could return here. We have our doubts.

**GEORGIA 48 Charlotte 3.** Our power ratings really like Georgia here. The problem is they are off a big win vs Texas and have a big game vs Georgia Tech on deck. Kirby Smart is also 0-14-1 ATS laying 38 or more with an average non-cover of 11.3 ppg.

**HOUSTON 28 TCU 26.** Houston is coming off a bye. TCU is coming off their worst performance of the season as they were crushed at BYU. TCU has the better ypp margin (+0.8 vs +0.6) and has played the tougher schedule (No. 38 vs No. 71). We bet Houston -1.5 thinking the market would go to -3. That hasn't happened.

**BOISE STATE 31 Colorado State 14.** Not sure you can trust Boise State here laying this kind of number with the backup QB. They've scored 14 points in their last two games combined. Yes, Colorado State is bad but the Rams had one of their better efforts last week in a 3-point loss at New Mexico. We're passing.

**UTAH 35 Kansas State 19.** While they probably won't make the playoffs, we think Utah is one of the best 12 teams in the country. They are No. 4 in scoring margin at +25.5. Still, this is a big number to lay vs a proud Kansas State program. The Wildcats did almost lose to lowly Oklahoma State last week. Pass.

**Arizona State 28 COLORADO 21.** Could this be Coach Prime's final home game? We think so. Arizona State still has a chance to make the Big 12 Championship game (need Cincy to upset BYU). The Sun Devils barely escaped West Virginia last week. ASU has won five games by five points or less this year so it's tough trusting them.

**WYOMING 25 Nevada 17.** Nevada is off one of the most shocking scores of the CFB season. The Wolf Pack beat San Jose State 55-10 as 9.5-point underdogs covering the spread by 54.5 points! Is that a one-off or will that give them momentum?

**ARIZONA 32 Baylor 27.** Baylor is just 2-8 ATS this season and we wonder if Dave Aranda will be there next season if they don't finish strong. Arizona is cooking with three straight wins and got an upset road win at Cincinnati last week. It could come down to turnovers where Baylor is -10 and Arizona is +10. We haven't bet side or total.

**California 26 STANFORD 22.** The "Big Game" sees Stanford lead the series 65-51-1 but Cal has won four straight. Both teams come in off a bye. A win by either would rubber-stamp solid seasons as both would go OVER their win totals. All three of Stanford's wins this year have come at home but we don't like their No. 129 offense in ypp vs the Cal defense. Lean Cal.

**TEXAS 33 Arkansas 23.** Arkansas is 2-8. Arkansas has still outscored their opponents on the season by a total of 18 points. They are +44 ypg. Excluding the 43-point loss to Notre Dame, their other seven losses have come by a combined 26 points! Arkansas has played the No. 7 schedule and have a better ypp margin than Texas (+1.0 vs +0.9). How does Texas respond after getting crushed vs Georgia? Can Arkansas keep picking itself up off the mat after another heart-breaker?

**Washington 31 UCLA 20.** One-factor handicap here. If Nico Iamaleava plays, UCLA +10.5 is worth a look, if he doesn't...Washington is worth a bet. The Huskies crushed Purdue last week and UCLA has now lost 3 straight after that mid-season win streak with the interim.

**SAN DIEGO STATE 30 San Jose State 17.** San Diego State is now in the driver's seat when it comes to the MWC Champ game. Who will they play? It won't be San Jose State who suffered one of the worst losses in CFB this season. The Spartans lost 55-10 as 9.5-point favorites to Nevada! They fired their DC and ST's coordinators this week.

**UTEP 26 New Mexico State 22.** The Battle of I-10! UTEP leads the series 60-39-2. Both have been eliminated from bowl contention and just playing for pride at this point. UTEP is much better in ypp margin (-0.2 vs -1.0) despite playing a similar schedule. Our ratings like them and the OVER as both teams run tempo.

**OREGON 35 USC 25.** The loser is out of the playoffs in our opinion. Yes, that includes Oregon who would not have a marquee win. With that being said, we like the Ducks here. They rank No. 1 in ypp margin, No. 1 in ypg game. They have the far superior defense allowing just 4.0 yards per play (No. 3) while USC ranks No. 72. We also bet the OVER with two Top 3 offenses in ypp and two teams who have seen their scoring curbed by bad weather in recent weeks.

**MIDDLE TENNESSEE 29 Sam Houston State 25.** Somehow Sam Houston has pulled off back-to-back shocking upsets as double-digit dogs. However, can you trust this 1-9 MTSU team laying a TD?

**Liberty 21 LOUISIANA TECH 20.** Liberty lost another game outright as a favorite. That's 7 now in the last two years and they're out of CUSA contention. LT might as well be out too. They're down to a 3rd string QB and managed 3 points last week. Lean UNDER.

**SMU 29 Louisville 26.** SMU still has a chance at getting to the ACC Championship. Louisville has blown their opportunity losing outright as a home favorite the last two games. They missed three kicks in the 1-point loss to Clemson last Friday. The Cardinals are better in ypp margin and have the better run game and defense. Still what is their frame of mind after the last two games?

**KENNESAW STATE 28 Missouri State 23.** Kennesaw is off their first conference loss of the season. They've failed to cover their last two games as a favorite. Missouri St has covered four straight. They can't qualify for the CUSA championship game but are hoping to get a bowl waiver. We like UNDER here which is 8-2 in Missouri St games.

**Illinois 23 WISCONSIN 14.** Bielema vs his former team. The Badgers have not quit on the season as they've covered three in a row. Those were all in the double-digit underdog role. We're not sure how their No. 135 offense keeps pace here. We like UNDER which has cashed in six straight Wisconsin games by 10.1 points per game.

**North Texas 38 RICE 21.** The tie-breakers in the American will come down to computer ratings so North Texas might be going for style points here if given the opportunity. We bet OVER.

**IOWA STATE 27 Kansas 24.** Both teams come in off a bye. Neither team was in great form prior to the bye as Iowa State had lost four of five while Kansas had lost three of four. Kansas is better in ypp margin (+0.3 vs +0.0) and we always prefer Iowa State head coach Matt Campbell as a dog, not as a favorite. Also like UNDER.

**South Florida 43 UAB 24.** After last week's upset loss to Navy, the Bulls are likely done in the AAC and G5 playoff races. Their coach Alex Golesh is a hot name in coaching circles. Will they be totally dialed in here? UAB got crushed last week on the scoreboard but not in the box score vs North Texas. We bet UAB +21.5.

**TEXAS STATE 36 UL-Monroe 20.** Texas State finally played to their ability last week crushing Southern Miss. Despite a 4-6 record, the Bobcats are in the Top 40 in ypp margin and ypg margin. Our ratings lean ULM but how can ULM's No. 131 scoring offense keep pace with the No. 12 Texas State offense? ULM is 2-8 ATS failing to cover by 6.8 points per game. Texas State has lost 9 times outright as a favorite though the last two years.

**† Northwestern 22 Minnesota 19.** @Wrigley Field in Chicago, IL. Northwestern lost by only 2 to Michigan last week. It should have been much worse as they got outgained 496-245. Minnesota has extra time to prep after playing on Friday night. We like Northwestern in the underdog role, not laying more than a FG.

**IOWA 30 Michigan State 14.** Despite a 6-4 record, we think Iowa is a Top 20 team. Their defense ranks in the Top 10 in ypp, ypg and ppg despite facing some of the best offenses in the country. Tough laying 3 scores though with their No. 133 tempo. MSU has lost 7 straight but have covered in five of them.

**East Carolina 31 UTSA 28.** ECU has a good shot to make the AAC Championship game if they win out. They rank high in the computers and would get boosted with a win here. Easier said than done as UTSA is 32-4 SU in the Alamo Dome under head coach Jeff Traylor.

**VANDERBILT 30 Kentucky 21.** Vandy still has playoff hopes if they can win out. They come in off a much-needed bye as their defense was starting to wear down vs Texas and Auburn. Kentucky is playing their best ball of the season with 3 straight wins and covers. They're thinking bowl bid. We didn't bet side or total.

**LSU 37 Western Kentucky 13.** It looks like LSU QB Garrett Nussmeier will be out again here. How much effort does WKU put into this game with a huge CUSA game at Jacksonville State on deck? We think LSU opens it up on offense a bit.

**TROY 32 Georgia State 21.** Georgia State is a nation-worst 1-9 ATS failing to cover by 9.2 points per game. Troy is off an embarrassing 33-0 loss to ODU. We didn't bet side or total.

**Southern Miss 28 SOUTH ALABAMA 26.** Finally Southern Miss got exposed last week in a blowout loss to Texas State. They're facing a dangerous South Alabama team here who has the better defense (No. 57 vs No. 93) and better run game (No. 25 vs No. 77). Close.

**Jacksonville State 28 FIU 27.** FIU got a nice OT upset win over Liberty last week despite playing without starting QB Jenkins. They're facing a Jacksonville State team that remains unbeaten in league play.

**NOTRE DAME 45 Syracuse 7.** It's looking more and more like ND will go from 0-2 to making the CFB playoffs. The Irish got a resounding win over Pitt last week. Meanwhile, the Orange losers of 7 straight, will start a walk-on at QB. ND might still be going for style points.

**New Mexico 29 AIR FORCE 25.** One factor handicap. Air Force will be playing without QB Szarka here. We've seen the line go from Air Force -1 to +3.5. We weren't wild about New Mexico's performance vs Colorado State last week though.

**FRESNO STATE 26 Utah State 24.** Both teams in the mix for the MWC Championship especially Fresno State. Utah State would be in better position if not for missing four kicks in double OT loss at UNLV last week. The Aggies are better in ypp margin (+0.7 vs +0.4) and have played the tougher schedule (No. 87 vs No. 110).

## Games in Rotation Order

### Thursday, November 20th

**Buffalo 23 HOUSTON 18.** The Bills rebounded after their shocking loss to the Dolphins. They trailed Tampa Bay 32-31 in the 4Q but scored the game's final 13 points. Now they're traveling on a short week to take on a Houston team that is .500 for the first time this season. The Texans have had a pair of last-second wins the last two weeks. CJ Stroud will miss his 3rd straight game with a concussion and Davis Mills will get the start. We've seen this line climb from Bills -2.5 to -6. We prefer the UNDER.

### Sunday, November 23rd

**CHICAGO 23 Pittsburgh 21.** The Bears continue to defy expectations with yet another last-second win on Sunday. Since their 0-2 start, Chicago is 7-1 with 5 of those wins coming by 5 points or less. Chicago is +18 in turnovers in that stretch. The Bears are -0.4 in ypp margin and rank No. 25 in DVOA despite their 7-3 record. They're overrated Pittsburgh also has a negative yards per play margin (-0.2) but rank No. 14 in DVOA and rank higher in Sagarin and strength of schedule. Aaron Rodgers is pushing to play but doctors must clear him after he suffered a left wrist injury vs Cincinnati. We're passing for now.

**BALTIMORE 30 N.Y. Jets 17.** With four straight wins, the Ravens are back to .500 and firmly in the playoff hunt. They should easily be favored in their next four before closing with New England and road trips to Green Bay and Pittsburgh. The Jets have extra time to prep after falling to the Pats. They rank No. 26 in ypp margin and No. 27 in DVOA but have a winning ATS mark. We prefer OVER to the side.

**DETROIT 31 N.Y. Giants 20.** The Detroit Lions are 13-0 straight up and 13-0 ATS off an outright loss dating back to November of 2022. It's the longest winning streak off an outright loss for any team in the last 30 years. If the season ended today, the Lions would be sitting at home for the playoffs. Despite the fact they rank No. 3 in ypp margin, No. 4 in DVOA and No. 2 in Sagarin overall in the NFL. We think they play with a sense of urgency here. The Giants have played the toughest schedule in the NFL so far and find themselves and underdog for the 12th straight game. Jaxson Dart is trending to play in this game.

**New England 30 CINCINNATI 21.** The Patriots have won 8 games in a row (6-1-1 ATS). Their longest win streak since Tom Brady's final season (2019). Note it has come against the weakest slate in the NFL. The weak slate continues here vs a Cincinnati team that has a historically bad defense. The Bengals rank No. 31 in ypp margin and have only covered two of their last eight games. Obviously, New England teasers will be popular but we prefer the OVER here. Cincy games have gone 7-2 to the OVER and New England's offense has average 29 ppg during the win streak.

**Seattle 27 TENNESSEE 13.** Seattle lost to the Rams last week despite a 414-249 yard edge. The Seahawks were done in by Sam Darnold interceptions but somehow still covered on the road against one of the best teams in the NFL. Seattle ranks No. 1 in ypp margin and No. 1 in DVOA. Tennessee ranks No. 32 in ypp margin and No. 32 in DVOA. A true best vs worst matchup here. Seattle is also an NFL-best 8-2 ATS. More of the same here.

**GREEN BAY 23 Minnesota 17.** After back-to-back losses, Green Bay got a much-needed win last week at the Giants. It was a bit misleading as they got outgained but were +2 in turnovers. Green Bay has only covered once in their last eight games. They're taking on a reeling Minnesota team that has lost four of five (also 1-4 ATS). JJ McCarthy is not going to be the long-term answer for the Vikings. We don't see much value here at current.

**KANSAS CITY 27 Indianapolis 23.** The Chiefs have won the AFC West every year since 2016. That streak is in major jeopardy right now after last week's loss to the Broncos. KC is now 3.5-games back and if the playoffs started today, they'd be out. They are taking on arguably the biggest surprise of the NFL season as the Colts are 8-2 and off a bye. Keep in mind, Indy's season win total was only 6.5. The Colts rank No. 2 in ypp margin (+1.2) and No. 3 in DVOA but have faced one of the weakest schedules in the NFL. At 5-5, we just don't see the Chiefs dropping this game. A juiced "-3" a reasonable money-line price will be one of our favorite bets of the week.

## HOME TEAM IN CAPS

**Jacksonville 24 ARIZONA 23.** Jacksonville is off a dominant performance vs the Chargers. They limited L.A. to just 135 yards while racking up 345 in the 35-6 win. The Jags are still -0.4 in ypp margin on the season though. Meanwhile, the Cardinals had a misleading blowout loss to the 49ers. Arizona had a 488-281 yard edge but were -3 in turnovers. Despite a 3-7 record, Arizona is only -0.2 in ypp margin and have 5 losses by 4 points or less. We like the Cardinals at +3.

**LAS VEGAS 20 Cleveland 15.** Breaking news from Wednesday afternoon that Shedeur Sanders will make his first start here. He was awful in relief last week going 4 of 16 for 47 yards and an interception with a 2.4 QBR. That's right...TWO POINT FOUR! Cleveland enters with the No. 32 offense averaging just 4.0 yards per play. The Raiders are also a complete mess on offense ranking No. 30 in ypp. Pete Carroll directed Chip Kelly to call 32 pass plays to just 3 runs in the first half on MNF. This should be a "one and done" season for Pete. The Raiders have taken the money this week with this line going from -2 to -4 (mainly fading Shedeur).

**NEW ORLEANS 20 Atlanta 18.** Breaking news from Wednesday afternoon that Michael Penix will undergo season-ending surgery for a partially torn ACL. Penix has significant injury history back to his days at Indiana so this is a major blow for his career prospects. Kirk Cousins will get the start for the Falcons. It's a terrible spot for Atlanta as they are off back-to-back OT game and traveling for the third time in four weeks. Meanwhile the Saints are off a bye. New Orleans games have gone UNDER in six straight.

**Philadelphia 25 DALLAS 23.** Philadelphia has won and covered four straight. They were -1.4 in yards per play margin vs the Lions on SNF. Despite a 8-2 record, the Eagles are -0.1 in ypp margin. Meanwhile, Dallas is +0.0 in ypp margin despite being 4-5-1. The Cowboys easily took care of the Raiders on MNF. These two met in the NFL season-opening game with Philly winning 24-20 but Dallas taking home the money as 8-point underdogs. We like Dallas getting the hook here. Lots of money on the UNDER but Dallas' games are on a 6-1 run to the OVER.

**L.A. RAMS 28 Tampa Bay 21.** Tough spot here for Tampa Bay making a long trip for the 2nd week in a row against one of the NFL's best. Last week they led the Bills 32-31 in the fourth quarter but gave up a couple of scores late. They've now lost 3 of their last 4 games. The Rams are playing back-to-back home. They had a misleading win over the Seahawks last week as they got outgained 414-249 but were +3 in turnovers in the 2-point win. The Rams rank No. 2 in DVOA.

### Monday, November 24th

**SAN FRANCISCO 28 Carolina 21.** The Panthers got another improbable win last week as they rallied from a 21-7 deficit to beat the Falcons in OT. They are now on a 5-0 run in games decided by 7 points or less since Week 2. The 49ers welcomed back Brock Purdy last week and they crushed the Cardinals 41-22. It was misleading as they got outgained 488-281 but were +3 in turnovers. Purdy was a solid 19 of 26 for 200 yards and 3 TD's after missing six games. Both teams are playing a 12th straight week. There's a battle in the market on the side. We prefer OVER.
