

Commission Meeting
March 9, 2026

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner Kyle White, East District Commissioner Chet Owen and County Clerk Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll opened the meeting with a prayer & led all those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

West District Commissioner Kyle White made the motion to approve the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes from the March 3rd meeting. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen seconded the motion. Motion carried.

David Porter of Blue Bird Fiber & Ivan Moore of ADB Companies met with the Commission to discuss running fiber into the Courthouse for ACCD 911 as a backup for INDIGITAL for our 911 system. They will cut the yard on the nw corner but have agreed to put the yard back in the same condition it is or better.

At 9:30 a.m. bids for Sales Tax Rock were opened. Bids were received from Norris Quarries, now known as Martin Marietta and Trager Quarries. After reviewing the bids Norris came in with the lowest bid and they are located in the County.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to accept the bid from Norris with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor. White-aye, Carroll-aye and Owen-aye. Motion carried 3-0.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek reminded all that the question to renew the sales tax rock was on the ballot for April & it needed to pass in order to continue the 110 ton to the mile of rock that is spread. The election is April 7th and the results will be known on the 8th, She will make sure Jim Knox of Norris Quarries is aware of this. They are also aware that no yellow rock is to be spread for sales tax rock due to the many complaints the county gets.

At 10 a.m. mowing bids were to be opened but none were received. County Clerk, Melissa Meek will make some calls to see if anyone can be found to mow.

Garry McFee of Howe & Company met with the Commission to have BRO documents signed.

At 10:30 a.m. tube bids were opened with Randy Dillon of Viebrock in attendance as well as Brian Testerman of Metal Culverts. After review of both bids West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to accept the bids from both vendors with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray will have the ability to order tubes from each vendor for whatever project he is working on at the time. All in favor, White-aye, Carroll-aye & Owen-aye. Motion carried. 3-0.

Courthouse security was discussed and how it is conducted. The Commission is considering open access exception of court days. The Commission will meet with Circuit Judge Ryan Horsman & Sheriff Kasey Keesaman to revisit if this is something that could be accomplished.
