Last Sunday, October 26, we celebrated both Reformation Sunday and our Commitment Sunday, when we give and receive our pledges for the work of God through Burke Lutheran Church for the next year.

If you were able to join us, I hope you enjoyed worship and the delicious meal prepared by Gwen Bosben. And I want to thank Linda H. and Mary T. for helping with the clean up. If you weren't able to make it, we will still receive pledges for a couple of weeks until we make our final count.

To encourage you to return your pledge, I'm printing here the presentation the Council asked me to give Sunday after we were done eating.

Do you know why we pledge?

Sometimes we think of pledging to church as the first step in preparing the church's budget, like we can only plan to spend as much money as we pledge. But that's not how any of that works.

Honestly, if we were really doing this right, we would have next year's budget done before we ask for pledges. Just like in your own household, so many of our expenses are set by forces outside our control. We don't have any control on how much postage costs, or the charges for electricity. So we start with the ballpark estimate of how much the work of the church will cost for the next year.

We anticipated that it would cost around \$206,000 to operate the church in 2025. The end of September shows we have spent \$157,000, which is right around 75% of the estimate. So we're probably going to end of pretty close.

So why do we ask for pledges, if it's not to plan our budget? We ask you to pledge as a sign of your faithfulness to God's work through this church and among us. We pledge to donate to the church because we believe that God is indeed working through us and this place. So we pledge our part of the budget, our tithe, to make sure God's work is done.

Last year, when we asked for pledges, 31 families pledged a total of \$147,300.

Right now, 14 of those families are actually ahead of their pledge. 16 families are behind on their pledge, but there's still plenty of time left in the year. And that's good news for all of us. There's still time left in this year to donate to the work of Burke Lutheran Church.

And we are giving you this opportunity to pledge to the work of the church in the next year. If you already turned in your pledge, we thank you. If you have it to turn in, you can place it in the offering plate at worship or mail it back to the church. And if you need one, there are extra copies available.

And yes, we are asking each of us to increase our contributions for next year. This year, we are only asking for a modest increase – a half of 1%. That's an extra nickel in addition to every \$10 you plan on contributing! Or fifty cents on top of a hundred. Or \$5 on top of the \$1000 you pledge. That's not too much. But cumulatively, it means that we would accomplish so much more next year. We are asking you to increase your pledge to the church as a sign of your increased commitment to Jesus' work here.

But mostly, we want to thank you. We want to thank you for your contributions over this last year. We want to thank you for being part of Burke Lutheran Church. It's good for us to be together and to celebrate together being Jesus' church. It's too easy for us to forget the joy that comes from being together when we are so busy and worried over too many things. And we want to thank you for pledging for next year. So thank you! And God bless you!
