write a book full of the details of your greatness.

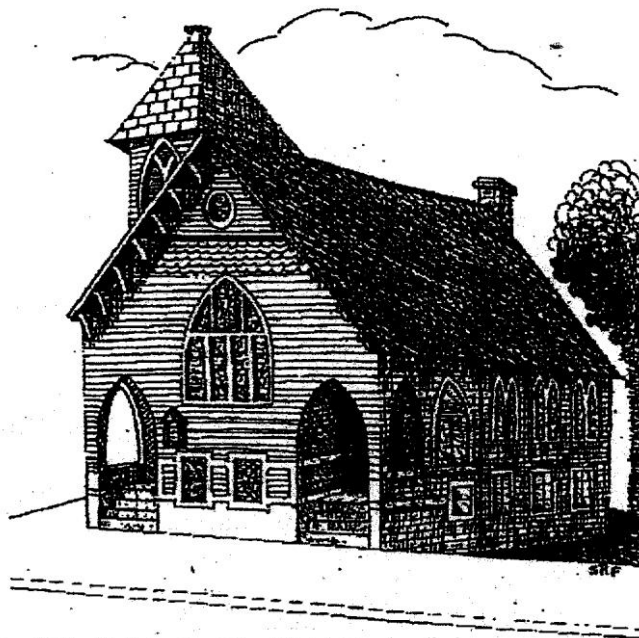
7The fame of your goodness spreads across the country;

Sermon Title: "Why We Overlook Offenses"

The Jewish historian Josephus used the word taksis when he recorded the orderly way in which the Roman army erected their camps — indicating their camps were orderly, organized, and well-planned. The commanders didn't engage in last-minute planning. Their camps were not hastily thrown together but rather set up in an organized and thoughtful manner. Amen
