Leslie J. Weiss, 62, prominent Port Hope area farmer, passed away Saturday morning, April 13, 2002 at his home following an apparent heart attack. Born in Harbor Beach on May 18, 1939, he was the son of the late Fred and Mabel (Maschke) Weiss. Les and Mary Goniwicha were united in marriage on Feb. 27, 1960 in Port Hope. Together they farmed with their family near Port Hope for more than 42 years. He was a member of St. John Lutheran Church in Port Hope and he enjoyed playing cards, especially euchre and visiting with friends. He enjoyed selling fertilizer and seed and investing in real estate.
