INFORMATION FOR SCOUTS OF TROOP 78

Event Check In: Saturday, 8:00 AM at Camp Ware Dining Hall Porch.

Program Begins: 9 AM Sharp at Camp Ware!

GETTING THERE:

Due to the Covid pandemic, each Scout will have to provide their own transportation. Plan to arrive at Camp Ware at 8:00 AM on Saturday morning and look for our troop. Activities on Saturday will begin promptly at 9:00 AM at Camp Ware. Pick up time on Sunday will be at 9:30 AM. Note: We have not yet been told if we are camping at Ware or at Horseshoe on Saturday night.

PREPARATION:

PATROL LEADERS should get their headcount to the SPL by **January 31**st. Patrol leaders are responsible for bringing patrol supplies (per the list provided) and making sure your "dog" sled is in good repair.

Patrol Needs: Klondike Sled, 2 - Six-foot staves, Patrol first aid kit, Blanket/tarp, Compass, Natural fire building materials, fire starters, 10 feet of rope, Camaraderie!

Each participant must bring a signed copy of the attached permission slip, and the Chester County Council Weekend Camping waiver found here:

WHAT TO WEAR and BRING:

All scouts must dress for cold weather – wear layers of warm clothing, you must have gloves and hats to compete. You must wear boots – positively no sneakers. Rain gear (if needed)
Water bottle & Drinking cup

Sleeping bag and pillow,
Flashlight or headlamp
Change of clothes packed in a duffel bag
MASK(s)

HOW DO I RESERVE A SPOT?

Tell your Patrol Leader by Sunday January 31st that you will be joining us. **Food cost is \$20 for adults** (collected at camp) and free for Scouts and visiting Webelos (and their dads).

ASPL's and Junior Leaders should let Logan Duff know if you are going.

ADULT LEADERS and Dads needed to attend.

Please contact Jack Bilson if you can attend.

KLONDIKE EVENTS:

- **1.** Each patrol's klondike sled should be 'modeled' to reflect their favorite essential worker's mode! Judging based on originality, functionality and creativity!!
- **2.** Your entire patrol must race your modified sled through the obstacle course in the shortest amount of time!
- **3.** The patrol's task will be to tie eight (8) scout knots as fast as possible:

square knot, - taunt line hitch,

clove hitch,
timber hitch,
2 half hitches,
bowline,
sheet bend,
sheepshank

- **4.** Each scout in the patrol gets two (2) arrows to shoot, scoring based on arrows hitting targets averaged out by the number of shooters.
- **5.** String burning -This event is scored on time to burn through the highest string. There is a 12-minute time limit including set-up...
- **6.** First Aid kit, two six-foot staves and a tarp required at a minimum.
- **7.** Two-man saw for Scouts BSA/Venturers, Bow saw for Webelos)
- **8.** Scouts will be given three tomahawks to throw and be scored on sticks and accuracy.
- **9.** Scouts can test their mettle tossing the 'Big Bertha' log the furthest. Distance counts!
- **10.** Slingshot pit for accuracy and scores for hits. Fives paintball shots per scout.
- **11.** Trolleys? Event will be a timed, patrol relay event using pairs of scouts 'trolleying' around part of the camp!
- **12.** Your job, as a patrol, is to 'orient' yourselves through a small course at Camp Ware in the shortest amount of time.
