Misleading Finals

Utah (-10.5) beat Kansas 31-21. However, Kansas had a 477-414 yard edge. Kansas was intercepted at the Utah-25, intercepted at the Utah-12 and missed a FG. A 97-yard "Pick 6" for the Utes was the play of the game.

Clemson (+2.5) upset South Carolina 28-14. However, South Carolina had a 422-415 yard edge. Clemson was +3 in turnovers which included a "Pick 6".

Duke (-2) beat Wake Forest 49-32. However, Wake had a 468-378 yard edge but were -4 in turnovers.

UL-Lafayette (-11) beat UL-Monroe 30-27 in OT. However, ULM had a 516-338 yard edge. ULL got a 96-yard kick return TD.

Minnesota (+2.5) upset Wisconsin 17-7. However, Wisconsin had a 268-218 yard edge but were -3 in turnovers. One of the turnovers set up a 10-yard TD "drive."

USC (-21.5) beat UCLA 29-10. UCLA led 10-7 late in the third quarter.

Western Michigan (-10) beat Eastern Michigan 31-21. However, EMU had a 461-378 yard edge but were -5 in turnovers. WMU got 4 TD's off those turnovers.

The line in the Arkansas State/Appalachian State game was "Pick". Arkansas State got a TD with :42 left to go up 30-29. Appalachian State missed a 45-yard FG on the final play. It also allowed Arkansas State to go OVER their 5.5 win total.

Week 15 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past eight seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 506-441-14 (53.4%) clip! Last week our computer went 2-1 and for the season now stands at 19-30-3. That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

With only nine games in total, there are ZERO games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the point spread this week.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Every Sunday in Vegas at 11am PT, Circa Sports is one of the first books in the world to release CFB lines and we bet them every week. We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). In 2023, we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). So far this season we are 241-195-1 55.3% (CLV 318-75-44 +1.70 ppg) Below is some of what we bet already for Week 15.

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Friday, December 5th

CUSA Championship - AmFirst Stadium - Jacksonville, AL

Kennesaw State 30 JACKSONVILLE STATE 28. This is a stunning matchup considering Jacksonville State was 25/1 to win the conference in the summer and Kennesaw was 50/1. Both first-year coaches have done a wonderful job. It is a rematch of a game played three weeks ago. Jacksonville State beat Kennesaw State 35-26 as 3.5-point underdogs (total was 56). Kennesaw deserved better in the game as the Owls had a 579-451 yard edge but were done in by a -4 turnover margin. Both teams won thrillers last week with Kennesaw beating Liberty 48-42 in double OT while Jacksonville State beat Western Kentucky 37-34. This is the 4th road game in 5 weeks for Kennesaw while Jacksonville is playing their 3rd home game in 4 weeks. Both teams are +0.2 in ypp margin but Kennesaw did play the slightly tougher schedule. Kennesaw opened up an underdog in this game on Sunday and we took advantage. We lean UNDER at current.

Sun Belt Championship - Bridgeforth Stadium - Harrisonburg, VA

JAMES MADISON 35 Troy 14. James Madison has an outside shot of making the playoffs provided Duke upsets Virginia in the ACC Championship game. JMU has been crushing their opponents as of late as they rank No. 7 in ypp margin (+2.2), No. 5 in ypg margin (+197.9) and No. 8 in scoring margin (+21.8). Unless they make the playoffs, this will be the final game for head coach Bob Chesney who is heading to UCLA. On the other side, Troy got here thanks to an upset win at Southern Miss last week as 6.5-point underdogs. Despite the 8-4 record, the Trojans offense has struggled this year as they rank No. 122 in ypp. Their OL has been a mess as they have allowed a nation-worst 49 sacks. That's not good news vs a JMU defense that held Coastal Carolina to MINUS-5 yards rushing last week. We can't get our ratings high enough for this one and we do think there could be distractions for JMU. We lean Troy and OVER here.

AAC Championship - Yulman Stadium - New Orleans, LA

North Texas 32 TULANE 31. The winner is heading to the CFB Playoffs so it is arguably one of the biggest games in history for both schools. The problem is both of their coaches are heading to greener pastures as North Texas head coach Eric Morris is off to Oklahoma State while Tulane head coach Jon Sumrall is off to Florida. Both will coach in this game and will remain with the team if they make the playoffs but with Signing Day today (Wednesday), there will be plenty of distractions. The two teams did not play against one another in the regular season. North Texas is the stronger team statistically with the No. 1 offense in the country averaging 512 ypg and 46.8 ppg. North Texas is also 10-2 ATS this year covering their games by an average of 9.6 ppg. Tulane did play the tougher schedule (No. 75 vs No. 104). We bet Tulane and UNDER on the openers and would prefer the UNDER at current as it could be rainy night. In our summer guide, we did have a North Texas 18/1 ticket to win the conference.

Mountain West Championship - Albertsons Stadium - Boise, ID

BOISE STATE 32 UNLV 26. These two are meeting for the 4th time in the last two years. Boise has won and covered each of the previous three meetings. That includes a match-up on October 18th here. Boise won 56-31 as a 13-point home favorite (total 60). After that game, Boise lost QB Maddux Madsen and lost a couple of games. However, Madsen has been cleared to return here but will there be some rust? UNLV is playing their best ball of the season with 4 straight wins as their much-maligned defense has allowed just 16 ppg the last month. They still rank No. 126 nationally allowing 6.4 yards per play for the season. UNLV has the better ypp margin (+0.7 vs +0.5) but Boise has played the tougher schedule (No. 83 vs No. 109) and there is some noise in their stats with Madsen missing the last 3.5 games. Our ratings like Boise here as they win and cover a 4th straight game vs UNLV.

Saturday, December 6th

Big 12 Championship - AT&T Stadium - Arlington, TX

† **Texas Tech 31 Byu 18.** A rematch of a November 8th meeting that saw Texas Tech win 29-7 as 13.5-point home favorites. Texas Tech has not played the toughest schedule (No. 69) but they've been dominant. They rank No. 5 in ypp margin (+2.5), No. 3 in ypg margin (+230.3) and No. 2 in scoring margin (+31.9). The Red Raiders are a nation-best 11-1 ATS covering their games by an average of 9.9 ppg. If it weren't for a mid-season injury to QB Morton, they'd probably be 12-0. The Cougars were 30/1 to win the Big 12 in the summer after QB Retzlaff was dismissed. They've over-achieved big-time with a 9-3 ATS mark covering their games by 7.8 ppg. They do have a +12 turnover margin and three close wins. They should be fired up keeping their head coach Kalani Sitake from Penn State this week. It won't be enough though.

MAC Championship - Ford Field - Detroit, MI

† **Western Michigan 23 Miami, OH 21.** This is a rematch of October 25th meeting that saw Miami, OH win 26-17 as 2-point home favorites. The Redhawks outscored the Broncos 17-0 in the fourth quarter. That was WMU's only loss in the last 9 games as they are making their first appearance in the MAC Championship since 2016. Meanwhile, Miami is making their 3rd straight appearance. After they struggled playing without QB Dequan Finn vs Toledo, the Redhawks went to redshirt freshman Thomas Gotkowski and the offense has come alive including a season-high 45 points last week vs Ball State. He will be facing a tough WMU defense that ranks in the Top 20 in ypg and ppg allowed. Miami has been better in the stats with a +0.8 ypp margin (WMU +0.0). We bet Miami +3 on the openers and so far the market agrees. However, won't see much value a current though.

SEC Championship - Mercedes-Benz Stadium - Atlanta, GA

† **Georgia 26 Alabama 23.** Alabama has dominated this rivalry winning 10 of the last 11 meetings. That includes snapping Georgia's 33-game home win streak earlier this year. The Tide were 2.5-point road underdogs and again find themselves 2.5-point underdogs. Technically it is a neutral site but Georgia will have the crowd edge and just played in this stadium last week. Speaking of that game, UGA's offense was abysmal as they managed a season-low 16 points and 260 yards. And that was against a Georgia Tech defense that ranks No. 90 in total defense! We expect a bounce-back effort here. Alabama also struggled last week. While they jumped out to a 17-0 lead at arch-rival Auburn, it was tied 20-20 in the fourth quarter when the Tide scored the game-winning TD on 4th down. Alabama did get outgained by 131 yards in the game, their worst mark of the season. We've actually downgraded both in our power ratings since the start of the season. We hate to use the "they're due" handicap but when you have two evenly talented teams, you have to think Georgia, at some point, breaks through vs the Tide. Especially considering they controlled the line of scrimmage in the first game with 227 rushing yards.

ACC Championship - Bank of America Stadium - Charlotte, NC

† **Virginia 30 Duke 26.** Nothing against Duke but they should not be playing in this game. At 7-5 the Blue Devils got here on a ridiculous tie-breaker over a more deserving 10-2 Miami team that could get shut out of the playoffs. The whole conference could get shutout if Duke pulls the small upset. We're not calling for it though. UVA just won 34-17 at Duke on November 15th. The Cavaliers were 5-point road underdogs, but find themselves 3.5-point favorites here. Why the big change? Well, UVA dominated the first game with a 540-255 yard edge. They had a bye and then dominated rival Virginia Tech last week. Safe to say, they are playing their best ball of the season. Meanwhile, Duke got out-gained by 90 yards last week in a win over Wake Forest. UVA is +0.9 in ypp margin (Duke just +0.1) and has the much stronger defense (No. 21 vs No. 111). We bet UVA -2.5 on the openers and will be rooting hard for them so we don't see a 2nd Group of 5 team in the playoffs.

Big Ten Championship - Lucas Oil Stadium - Indianapolis, IN

† **Ohio State 27 Indiana 21.** Imagine how big this game would be if it were the BCS era? Still, it's the ever rare No. 1 vs No. 2 matchup in the regular season. All-time, No. 1 teams are 29-21-2 straight up. A 1 vs 2 matchup hasn't happened in a conference championship game since the 2009 SEC Championship between Alabama and Florida. The defending national champion Buckeyes are used to the big stage. They are led by not only the best defense in the country this year, but statistically one of the most dominant defenses in the last quarter century. They're only allowing 7.8 ppg and 203 ypg. Meanwhile, the Buckeyes offense saw the return of WR's Jeremiah Smith and Carnell Tate last week. However, it was the Buckeye run game that melted away the game in the second half vs Michigan. On the other side, Indiana does have the No. 1 scoring margin in the country at +33.4 and one of the Heisman favorites at QB in Fernando Mendoza. However, it has come against a schedule that ranks just No. 56 in terms of difficulty (according to Jeff Sagarin). Their upset of Oregon on the road earlier should give them some confidence here. However, Ohio State out-classed Indiana last year when they entered the game 10-0. While Indiana is a better team this year...we can't believe we're saying this...BUT Ohio State could be better too. The Buckeyes have been "load managing" for a playoff run as they run the slowest tempo in CFB. Their defense has faced only 647 plays this year (fewest in country). We think they have an extra gear which is scary considering the market has not had a good handle on them so far (OSU 10-1-1 ATS).

Thursday, December 4th

DETROIT 30 Dallas 26. If the season ended today, both teams would be out of the playoffs. Safe to say, this game is close to an elimination game. The Cowboys enter on a 3-game win streak having upset the Eagles and Chiefs the last two weeks. They're playing their best ball of the season. Meanwhile, the Lions are banged up and have failed to cover 4 of their last 5 games. They're playing their worst. Still, tough to ignore the full-season stats with Detroit being much better in ypp margin (+0.9 vs +0.2) and DVOA (No. 4 vs No. 16). We lean Detroit and OVER.

Sunday, December 7th

MINNESOTA 22 Washington 20. If you're wondering why the Vikings have flipped back to favorite, it looks like JJ McCarthy will be back here. As bad as McCarthy has been, undrafted rookie Max Brosmer did not look like an NFL QB last week. Brosmer threw 4 INT's and the Vikings were shutout for the first time since 2007. Meanwhile, the Commanders have now lost 7 straight games. They did get their first cover in that stretch last week in the heart-breaking 1-point OT loss to the Broncos. Minnesota is better in ypp margin (+0.0 vs -0.7). We're passing for now.

Miami 23 N.Y. JETS 21. Don't look now but the Dolphins have won 3 straight. All they have done is lessen their chances of getting Top 5 draft pick. If the goal is to win playoff games, this is a franchise that's in purgatory right now from the top down. Meanwhile, the Jets have some hope with a first-year coach. After starting 0-7, they are 3-2 SU and 4-0-1 ATS in their last 5 games. Miami is better in DVOA and ypp margin (-0.3 vs -0.6) but not enough to justify being a 3-point road favorite.

CLEVELAND 19 Tennessee 16. In CFB, we got a No. 1 vs No. 2 matchup this weekend, here we got two of the very worst in the NFL. The Titans enter 1-11 and rank dead last in ypp margin, DVOA and Sagarin rating. The Browns are bottom 5 in DVOA and Sagarin despite having DE Myles Garrett who is having one of the best seasons of all-time. The problem is an offense that ranks dead last in ypp and won't get any better with Shedder under center. Despite the horrific stats, the Titans have covered 3 of 4.

BALTIMORE 23 Pittsburgh 19. This game has the biggest single-game swings for playoff chances so far this season. Baltimore had won 5 straight but suffered a shocking upset loss to the Bengals on Thanksgiving. They are now only 4-8 ATS this year. Meanwhile, the Steelers have lost 3 of 4. Last week Aaron Rodgers had a 6.2 QBR as the Steelers were outscored 23-0 in the second half vs the Bills. Could we be staring at the first losing season under Tomlin? Totals players note the UNDER has gone 4-1 in both of the teams' last 5 games. We lean Pittsburgh.

Seattle 26 ATLANTA 20. Seattle comes in at 9-3 SU and 9-3 ATS. The Seahawks rank No. 1 in ypp margin and No. 1 in DVOA. However, they would only be the No. 5 seed in the NFC if the playoffs started today. Last week they notched their first shutout win since 2015. They're taking on an Atlanta team that is 1-6 SU in their last 7 games and had a misleading loss to the Jets. The Falcons were +1.5 in ypp and rank No. 9 (+0.4) for the season despite their 4-8 record. Seattle is playing their 3rd road game in 4 weeks and have huge games vs playoff teams on deck. Lean Falcons.

JACKSONVILLE 23 Indianapolis 22. If the season ended today, the Jags would be the No. 3 seed and the Colts would be the No. 6 seed. Safe to say, a lot on the line here. Daniel Jones is not 100% and the Colts offense is coming off their two worst back-to-back performances of the season. Meanwhile, Jacksonville is off three straight wins and covers. Indy is much better in the stats ranking No. 3 in ypp margin and DVOA while Jacksonville is No. 17 and No. 12. The Jags have played the tougher schedule (No. 11 vs No. 30). We like the Jags.

GREEN BAY 25 Chicago 19. The Bears are off the shocking upset of the Eagles as they ran for 281 yards. Chicago had two 100-yard rushers in a game for the first time since 1985. They have now won 9 of their last 10 games going 8-2 ATS. There's been some "smoke and mirrors" to it though as they are -0.5 in ypp margin (No. 23) and are the worst 9-3 team ever in the DVOA rankings. The Packers have won 3 straight and have extra time to prep having played on Thursday. Forecast is 15 degrees at kick. Pass for now.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

TAMPA BAY 24 New Orleans 17. Tampa got a win last week but the Bucs are on a 0-4 ATS run. They rank No. 26 in ypp margin (-0.6) despite a 7-5 record. That's actually worse than the 2-10 Saints who are -0.5 in ypp margin. Thanks to a Bottom 5 offense and an underrated defense, New Orleans has seen each of their last 8 games go UNDER the total. More of the same here as we lean UNDER and New Orleans.

Denver 23 LAS VEGAS 17. The Broncos have won 9 straight games. Seven of those have come by 4 points or less. That includes last week's 1-point OT win at Washington. They're playing a Las Vegas team that is 1-10 SU and 2-8-1 ATS since their opening week upset of New England. How shocking is that result now considering the Pats are 11-2? The Broncos have Green Bay, Jacksonville, at Kansas City and the Chargers on deck. We question how focused they'll be here plus they're not the team to get big margin.

L.A. Rams 27 ARIZONA 20. The Rams 6-game win streak was snapped last week as they suffered a shocking upset loss to Carolina as 10-point favorites. They still rank No. 2 in ypp margin, No. 2 in DVOA and No. 1 in Sagarin. How many close losses can the Cardinals take? They've lost 7 games this year by 4 points or less. While just 3-9, they are only below average in the stats. Slight lean on the Cardinals.

BUFFALO 28 Cincinnati 23. The Bengals were on a 1-8 SU run. However, Cincy saw the return of QB Joe Burrow and got the big upset win over Baltimore on Thanksgiving to remain alive in the mediocre AFC North. It was the defense who stepped up their game as the 14 points allowed was the fewest allowed all season for them. Buffalo's defense also stepped up last week as they outscored the Steelers 23-0 in the second half. The 7 points allowed was also their fewest of the season. Cincy has played the much tougher schedule (No. 9 vs No. 27) and their stats are skewed do to Burrow missing. We lean UNDER for now.

KANSAS CITY 23 Houston 19. You have to check the injury reports for this one. KC was missing three OL starters by the end of the Dallas game. If the playoffs started today both teams would be out. Obviously, Houston in better form with 4 straight wins including back-to-back upset over the Bills and Colts. The Chiefs are 1-3 SU and 0-4 ATS in their last 4 games. If KC can get 1 or 2 of the OL starters back, this is a rare "Buy Low" spot for the Chiefs who are in desperation mode.

Monday, December 8th

Philadelphia 22 L.A. CHARGERS 20. The Eagles come in off back-to-back upset losses. This is starting to look similar to the 2023 team that started 10-1 and unraveled. They allowed 281 yards rushing last week to the Bears. The Chargers have won 4 straight and have the better ypp margin (+0.4 vs +0.0). The problem is the Eagles have faced the much tougher schedule (No. 6 vs No. 31). Philly has extra time to prep having played on Black Friday. We think the Chargers are a nice teaser option with a low total.
