3. Old Business

Personal Property input from other Towns

Sebago, Denmark, Standish and Brownfield were contacted in regards to how their Town manages personal property. Some do not tax personal property. Sebago and Standish do pursue personal property. The State of Maine also requires for a Town to pursue personal property taxation. Baldwin will start by reviewing the list of businesses that have acquired conditional use permits to do business in Baldwin. After the review, the Selectmen will send out letters requesting businesses and residents to report their personal property. Need to work with planning board, the current list dates back to 2012, need to check for updated 2012 to current conditional use permits. The personal property taxes will be included in the Fall 2017 tax bills.

Foreclosure update

Town has reviewed foreclosures and will put foreclosed properties up for sale. Will contact two to three realtors to meet with and discuss options to sell town-owned property. Need to research more on a civil service deputy process regarding delivering foreclosure notices to residents that fail to claim their mail. Need to work on the 2014 upcoming foreclosures and track status in the spreadsheet currently in place. In the instance a resident pays the outstanding taxes on their property, the foreclosure will be discharged by the Town Clerk, rather than quitclaimed back to them.
