MANAGING THROUGH A PERFECT STORM

Over the years we have discussed the impact of the recession on our collective businesses. Thankfully we are seeing improvements in the economy and while they are slower than what we would like, they are having a positive impact. Construction and home building are on the rise and demand for goods and services are benefiting.

Unfortunately, during the recession many nurseries went out of business or could not afford to plant their fields with new "liners". Add to the mix the Emerald Ash Borer and diseases affecting common evergreen trees such as Austrian Pine and Colorado Spruce, and we have a perfect storm of high demand and limited supply.

For several years, nurseries were practically giving away trees to maintain some cash flow. Now with low supply and high demand, tree prices are increasing 10-20% per year.

To help manage this situation, we encourage you to consider planting smaller size trees and to be open to species flexibility to replenish your urban forest. Your account representative will be able to help you find the right solution for you.
