
OCIA - An Invitation to Come

Safety Reminder: Saint Olaf owns three Automated External Defibrillators (AED) machines: (1) On the wall near the south exit doors in the Father McNamara Center, (2) In the Votive Candle area of the back of the Church, and (3) In the School Legacy Building near the west doors. AED machines are easy to use - the person responding simply needs to turn the machine on and the AED machine will give audible instructions
