### Vision/Imagination - Part 10 By Wade Anderson

Let's pray: "Heavenly Father, I thank You for Your infinite wisdom. I thank You that You have supplied ALL of our needs, according to the finished work that Jesus accomplished on the Cross. I thank You for Your most wonderful Holy Spirit, the One that not only brings the pages of Your Word alive to us, but as well, lives on the inside of us to teach us, train us, correct us and even show us things that are coming our way. You, Sir, are our Rock, our sure foundation and the anchor that holds us steady, even when we make choices that could potentially cause us harm. Father, we're so grateful that You love us EVEN in our ignorance to not listen intently to Your Spirit. I praise You, Lord, that You love me enough to continue to correct me and teach me how to be the man You created me to be. It's in Jesus name that I pray and believe, AMEN! AMEN! And AMEN!"

As we concluded last month's newsletter message, I realized God had taken me deeper than I first thought 'I' was headed that morning I sat down to listen to His Spirit. I told you that we would pick back up, this month, to unpack some more of *Revelation 12:10*. We have a few more things to go over before we get there. So ready or not, here we go.

Let's first look at, "Now the Salvation, and the power, and the kingdom (dominion, reign) of our God, and the authority of His Christ have come." (Revelation 12:10a). Let's take a look at Colossians 2:15, where the Apostle Paul shares that Jesus DID defeat the devil, "When He had disarmed the rulers and authorities [those supernatural forces of evil operating against us], He made a public example of them [exhibiting them as captives in His trium-phal procession], having triumphed over them through the Cross." It's important to note that Paul wrote the Book of Colossians while he was in prison, in Rome. Because Paul had never visited the city of Colossae, one might conclude that this church was a direct result of other converts from Paul's mission travels that started this church. Even in prison, Paul had heard that this church was coming under attack, yes even with believers, attempting to wrap paganism, and secular philosophy with Christian doctrine. As Paul points to Colossians 2:9-10, "For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority," he states this to confront these false teachers AND points them towards where their sufficiency is found in no one else, but Christ!

I've shared this in other newsletters, but I'll do it again to help paint this vivid picture Paul is telling us about in *Colossians* 2:15. We might not fully understand the full level of what Paul was saying here, but these people were very familiar with what he was saying. In those days, the kings would go to war, in battle with their troops. When this happened, the kingdom under the rule of each king would be in suspense of what might happen to them IF their king lost. So, we could gather that they were more than likely on edge. They knew that if their king lost, they would automatically be under a new rule. This was the reality that they knew ... the winning king would cut the thumbs and big toes off of the loosing king, leading him through the streets with a rope around his neck. This showed each kingdom that 'this' king, the loser, had been stripped of his authority. After all, no king would allow such a display of defeat unless he were completely defeated.

The reason the big toes and the thumbs were cut off was to show the people that 'this' king would **NEVER** be a threat again. He would never be able to hold a sword in his hand again, nor would he ever run in battle against anyone. The people in each kingdom not only understood, "When He had disarmed the rulers and authorities, He made a public example of them [exhibiting them as captives in His triumphal procession]," but many times dreaded the outcome. This was the picture Paul was showing the church in Colossae. Sure, we did receive His authority when we first believed and asked Jesus into our lives. But it was because Jesus triumphed over the grave, at His resurrection, that brought the final blow to satan. Our real power came to us on the (AD) side of the Cross! Even if 'you' don't believe you have the power to stand against the liar, that doesn't change the Word of God that clearly states, YOU DO have the power and authority to stand against **ANYTHING** the liar brings before you! You just have to realize this truth and begin to operate in it! Listen how John affirms this, "*Little children (believers, dear ones), you are of God and you belong to Him and have [already] overcome them [the agents of the antichrist]; because He who is in you is greater than he (satan) who is in the world [of sinful mankind]." (1 John 4:4 AMP)* 

Now, in 2 Corinthians 4:3-4 (AMP), Paul tells us, "But even if our gospel is [in some sense] hidden [behind a veil], it is hidden [only] to those who are perishing; among them the god of this world [satan] has blinded the minds of the unbelieving to prevent them from seeing the illuminating light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God." First, the Greek word for hid/hidden is KALUPTO, which actually means; to cover, to hide, to hinder the knowledge of a thing. From this text we can see that it's satan's work to hinder, hide and cover the truths of the Gospel from all peoples. From my own previous experiences, living deep in the belly of worldly things, I NOW know first-hand that satan was hiding, through my own submission to his lies, the Gospel, the Good News about Jesus! I WAS one of those who was perishing.

In the New Testament, satan is depicted, in this above verse, as being the "god of this world", the prince of this world in John 12:31, 14:30, and 16:11, the prince of the devils in Matthew 12:24, the prince of the power of the air in Ephesians

2:2, and that old serpent, called the devil, as we've already seen, in Revelation 12:9.

Look for a second at, "For our struggle is not against flesh and blood [contending only with physical opponents], but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this [present] darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly (supernatural) places." (Ephesians 6:12) Here in Ephesians 6:12, the Apostle Paul emphasizes, "Against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this [present] darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly (supernatural) places" as spiritual warfare!! But this in NO WAY indicates that the devil has rule over the believer! Whether you believe it or not, God has allowed satan the authority, with his remaining time here on earth, to actively do his best to not only blind the minds of those who do not yet believe, but also do his best to hide or steal God's truths from the 'so called believers'. I say it like this to get your attention! Saying we are a believer doesn't scare the devil. Not at all!! The devil watches our actions and listens to the words that we speak. The devil KNOWS if you are a true follower by what he hears coming out of your mouth AND the way you live your life! Either way, he's coming for the Word, not you. It's sort of like Pooh Bear trying to get all of the honey out of a jar. At one point he knows there's more honey inside the jar and breaks it against a rock to get it all. Pooh only broke the jar to get ALL of what was in the jar. He didn't have anything against the jar, he just wanted the honey. Likewise, the devil comes to steal the Word that you have in you. If you don't believe this, then you are of no threat to satan, and he's probably already stolen most of what you once believed and is okay in leaving you alone, just saying.

In James 4:7, it tells us exactly how to combat his lies, "Submit yourselves therefore to God. RESIT the devil and he will flee from you." Brothers and sisters, I cannot over emphasize the importance of our submission to God and His Word! It's literally when someone is straddling the fence, hanging on to their so called 'worldly wisdom', that opens, and keeps open the door for satan to come in and just blindside them at every turn! And those people, when this happens, attempt to lay the responsibility on God, saying, "Where was God when I needed Him?" Surrendering to Him in submission to His Word is where we begin to understand the servanthood God has called us ALL too! THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT satan HAS AUTHORITY OVER GOD!! God and His Word ARE the final authority! And with that being the truth, we ALL need to fill ourselves with the Word of God and stay alert for the attacks of the enemy. If you have the Word inside of you, let me assure you, you WILL come under attack! But don't be alarmed by that statement, because the liar, like any bully, can't take anything from you that you don't release to him. STAND FIRM IN YOUR POSITION! STAY SUITED UP WITH HIS ARMOR! And remember, Jesus has already won the war, these are just the battles that we ALL face. We are already victors NOT victims!

ALL of what I have already written in these previous paragraphs is very relevant to not only the picture we've painted in our minds of who we are in Christ, but also equates to whether we see ourselves as victims or victors. And finally, this next verse is the answer to the earlier question, "Why is he telling us about all of these obstacles and trials?"

"And they overcame and conquered him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, for they did not love their life and renounce their faith even when faced with death." (Revelation 12:11) The 'him' that was overcome refers to the devil. We, as believers in Christ Jesus, overcome the devil by the blood of Jesus and the words of our testimonies. The blood of Jesus doesn't accomplish this alone. We all have a testimony of how that blood has affected our lives since making Jesus our Lord and Savior. (Romans 10:9-10) Many people might believe this is only speaking about us bearing witness of the initial event of Jesus coming into our lives. And if you believe that, then the liar has deceived you yet again! EVERY single time that Jesus has healed you, blessed you and kept you or your family from the clutches of the enemy is a testimony! It's all the seemingly small things that the liar is trying to keep you from sharing with those around you. It's like you building a wall of defense against the enemy with your testimony, each and every brick is important to lay to fortify that wall. It's not only your defense but it helps provide a place for others to witness, and build their wall, of truth! And the more times you tell your story, the stronger you become and the easier it is to see God was right there beside you all of the time.

Once we've given our old lives to Jesus and received these new lives, we SHOULD BE SO ALIVE INSIDE THAT ALL WE WANT TO DO IS TELL OTHERS ABOUT THIS AWESOME JESUS, THAT HE NOT ONLY FORGAVE ALL OF MY SINS, BUT AS WELL, LOVES ME IN SPITE OF WHAT I'VE DONE!! Brothers and sisters, we are called to be streams of living water, NOT stagnant ponds! Streams bring life to the things around them! If you are reading this, and you have received Jesus as your Lord and Savior, you have His life-giving power on the inside of you just waiting for you to open your mouth and share it with the world around you! This is exactly what "the word of their testimony" means.

Brothers and sisters, this is exactly what I did when I heard His Spirit tell me, "I'll NEVER remember your sins again." I knew the things that I'd done in my life that no one else knew. When I found out that Jesus knew it ALL and was giving me the invitation to empty that plate and never remember ANY OF IT AGAIN, that was the best news I'd EVER heard! That was when I knew I wanted everyone to hear about this Jesus also! Once I started to learn and understand how much the devil had lied and deceived me for so many years, I turned into a 'snitch'! Don't look at me like that! What I mean is; the

#### It's Not but Us – Part 2 By P.G.

We cannot let our faith be controlled by the storms of life or motivated by fear or failure. If we allow this to happen our faith becomes limited and restricts the power of God. One thing we have to remember is that the Word of God says, "He did not give us a spirit of fear, but a spirit of power of love and self-discipline." (2 Timothy 1:7). Our faith must go beyond reason without understanding why, we must take Gods Word as the final authority. What it says will come to pass. The Word of God says His Word will not return to Him void, the purpose it is sent out for will be fulfilled (Isaiah 55:11).

We must come to Him with a childlike faith to enter the Kingdom, and sometimes as mature believers we have to return to Him with a childlike faith, because the knowledge that puffs us up makes us prideful.

Childlike faith: "Assuredly, I say to you, who ever does not receive the Kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it." (Mark 10:15) The phrase 'assuredly, I say,' is saying be careful to listen to the truth about to be spoken. Childlike faith, childhood is the learning stage, a stage all believers want to remain at, a teachable stage. As we grow and mature, we get prideful and think we know it all, but to tell you the truth we are just scratching the surface. Childlike faith is a trusting dependence stage, where a child trusts every word, the parent tells the child. It is also where the child starts to show lots of affection toward the parent for all his or her accomplishments. The child could not have done it on their own, giving glory to the parents. We must at all times remain humble like a child, having the attitude that we achieve nothing of value in the Kingdom on our own. It is a gift from our Father, for His will and His glory alone, all we do is reflect it, and it is not of ourselves, so no mere man can boast. We have a helper, a guide, and a teacher that comes along side of us. It's important for us to always remember who we are doing this for, and that the throne our King Jesus sits on has room for only one, Him, Amen.

Samuel is a good example of a child with a childlike faith. The boy Samuel was born in answer to a prayer here in 1 Samuel: 1:11, "And she made a vow, saying, 'Lord Almighty, if you will only look on your servant's misery and remember me, and not forget your servant but give her a son, then I will give him to the Lord for all the days of his life, and no razor will ever be used on his head." Samuel's name means 'asked of God'. And as we see in Scripture, he was dedicated to the Lord before birth and was taken to Shiloh to be trained by the priest while very young. "After he was weaned, she took the boy with her, young as he was, along with a three-year-old bull, an ephah of flour and a skin of wine, and brought him to the house of the Lord at Shiloh. When the bull had been sacrificed, they brought the boy to Eli, and she said to him, 'Pardon me, my lord. As surely as you live, I am the woman who stood here beside you praying to the Lord. I prayed for this child, and the Lord has granted me what I asked of Him. So now I give him to the Lord. For his whole life he will be given over to the Lord.' And he worshiped the Lord there." (1 Samuel 1:24-28). In 1 Samuel 2:11 says, "Then Elkanah went home to Ramah, but the boy ministered before the Lord under Eli the priest." His duties were of an assistant or a helper, like opening the doors of the tabernacle (1 Samuel 3:15), and it says in 1 Samuel 2:18, that as a boy he wore a linen Ephod that priest only wore. But he remained humble, teachable, and stayed in the position God put him in until his time. We can exalt ourselves or allow the Lord to exalt us in His time. The Word of God says that "And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man." (Luke 2:52) Jesus waited for His time and was about the will of the Father even to the point of death.

Now I want to share 1 Samuel 3, from the Message Translation. Let's begin:

"The boy Samuel was serving 3rd chapter God under Eli's direction. This was at a time when the revelation of God was rarely heard or seen. One night Eli was sound asleep (his eyesight was very bad-he could hardly see). It was well before dawn; the sanctuary lamp was still burning. Samuel was still in bed in the Temple of God, where the Chest of God rested. Then God called out, 'Samuel, Samuel!' Samuel answered, 'Yes? I'm here.' Then he ran to Eli saying, 'I heard you call. Here I am.' Eli said, 'I didn't call you. Go back to bed.' And so he did. God called again, 'Samuel, Samuel, Samuel, Samuel, Samuel!' Samuel, Samuel!' Samuel, Samuel, 'Again Eli said, 'Son, I didn't call you. Go back to bed.' (This all happened before Samuel knew God for himself. It was before the revelation of God had been given to him personally.)

God called again, 'Samuel!'-the third time! Yet again Samuel got up and went to Eli, 'Yes? I heard you call me. Here I am.' That's when it dawned on Eli that God was calling the boy. So Eli directed Samuel, 'Go back and lie



down. If the voice calls again, say, 'Speak, God. I'm your servant, ready to listen.'" Samuel returned to his bed. Then God came and stood before him exactly as before, calling out, 'Samuel! Samuel!' Samuel answered, 'Speak. I'm your servant, ready to listen.' God said to Samuel, 'Listen carefully. I'm getting ready to do something in Israel that is going to shake everyone up and get their attention. The time has come for Me to bring down on Eli's family everything I warned him of, every last word of it. I'm letting him know that the time's up. I'm bringing judgment on his family for good. He knew what was going on, that his sons were desecrating God's name and God's place, and he did nothing to stop them. This is my sentence on the family of Eli: The evil of Eli's family can never be wiped out by sacrifice or offering.'

Samuel stayed in bed until morning, then rose early and went about his duties, opening the doors of the sanctuary, but he dreaded having to tell the vision to Eli. But then Eli summoned Samuel: 'Samuel, my son!' Samuel came running: 'Yes? What can I do for you?' 'What did He say? Tell it to me, all of it. Don't suppress or soften one word, as God is your judge! I want it all, word for word as he said it to you.' So Samuel told him, word for word. He held back nothing. Eli said, 'He is God. Let Him do whatever He thinks best.' Samuel grew up. God was with him, and Samuel's prophetic record was flawless. Everyone in Israel, from Dan in the north to Beersheba in the south, recognized that Samuel was the real thing-a true prophet of God. God continued to show up at Shiloh, revealed through His word to Samuel at Shiloh."

### Disappointed, of Course but I Continue to Believe By C.S.

For months I have been working on my parole packet, and finally went to my second Board of Parole Hearing. And unfortunately, I was denied another 3 years. I was in front of a panel of two commissioners and a D.A. for 3 hours, and by the time they were done picking my brain, I was mentally and emotionally drained. Was I disappointed? Of course, but I continue to believe that a denial is only a delay with the Lord. I just have more room to grow. I am aware that I've done a horrible thing, and imprisonment has given me the opportunity to understand the severity of the harm I have caused to reevaluate the direction of my life, and to sincerely begin addressing my need for change. And for the past 14 years I have been doing that. I'm sure that there are some people that don't believe I deserve my freedom after the ugly thing that I have done. But we do not need to look at anybody else's, let's look at our own transgressions. How many times do we violate God's will in what we think, say, or do? Our problem is sin, and the Bible says, *"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23)* God does not allow selective obedience, so to those who were trying to justify themselves by thinking they sin less than others has already stumbled.

The other day I was in the Book of Colossians and remembered the Apostle Paul saying, "I rejoice in my sufferings." Can we even imagine ourselves saying that? It's a difficult claim for me to make, much less to do it day after day in a place like this. In fact, it is impossible to do. The Apostle Paul was able to have such an attitude because he drew from Jesus' strength, and the same has been done for me. All through my 14 years of incarceration I've learned to live a spiritual life. And although my faith is strong. I still have to be aware of my surroundings if I want to survive in prison. I do this by minding my own business and keeping to myself. I don't think about the years, months or weeks like normal people. I think about **TODAY**, how to get through it, how to survive it. When I wake up tomorrow another day is behind me. The days add up, the weeks run together and before you know it the months become years. I then realize how tuff I am, how I can function, adapt, and survive, only because I have no choice. So, if you've ever met a loner, such as me, no matter what they tell you, it's not because they love solitude. It's because they have tried to blend into the world before, and people continue to disappoint them.

What matters to me is that I KNOW God loves me. He sees the good in me that others can't see. He sees what I am becoming and is not overly concerned about my faults or what others think or say. He's invited me to be in an intimate relationship with Him. All He wants is my willingness and open-mindedness to change and grow in Him. I believe that happiness is the consequence of personal effort, even in here. I fight for it, strive for it, and if I could, I would travel around the world for it. But, since I can't do that, I have to participate relentlessly in the manifestation of my own blessing. So regardless of the decision at mt parole hearing, I will continue in my daily walk with the Lord and always keep you and everyone else at the  $\mathfrak{OC} + \mathfrak{C}$  in my thoughts and prayers and strive to be the better version of myself so that no one will ever suffer such evil from me again.

Lenire also gave us the adjective lenient, which usually means "tolerant" or "indulgent" today but in its original sense carried the meaning of "relieving pain or stress". Often found in medical contexts, lenitive can also be a noun referring to a treatment (such as a salve) with soothing or healing properties.
