Jean-Claude Boisset Bourgogne Chardonnay (Les Ursulines 2023)

Jean-Claude Boisset is one of Burgundy's most compelling maisons, founded in 1961 in Nuits-Saint-Georges and known for its refined, contemporary approach to winemaking. Under the direction of Jean-Charles Boisset and winemaker Grégory Patriat, the house focuses on terroir-driven wines crafted with precision and minimal intervention. Working with carefully selected, often hand-harvested fruit from across Burgundy, Jean-Claude Boisset produces wines that emphasize purity, balance, and a clear sense of place. This Bourgogne Chardonnay reflects that contemporary philosophy, offering a fresh and mineral expression of the region with clarity and precision.

Vineyard and Terroir

- **Location:** Burgundy, across multiple sub-regions including Yonne, Côte d'Or, Côte Chalonnaise, and Mâconnais.
- **Soil Type:** Predominantly clay-limestone soils typical of Burgundy
- **Viticulture Practices:** Grapes are sourced from selected vineyard parcels across the region, allowing for a balanced expression of freshness, fruit, and regional diversity.



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Winemaking

- **Harvest:** Grapes are hand-harvested and collected in small perforated crates to preserve fruit integrity.
- **Vinification:** Whole-bunch pressing is followed by fermentation with indigenous yeasts. The wine is aged on fine lees in oak, including a small proportion of new oak, without racking or stirring to enhance texture while preserving freshness and mineral expression.



Tasting Notes

- **Appearance:** Pale yellow with light golden reflections.
- **Aroma:** Fresh and expressive, with citrus, white stone fruit, floral notes, and subtle smoky nuances.
- **Palate:** Lively and balanced, with bright acidity, mineral tension, and layered fruit expression.
- **Finish:** Clean and persistent, with a fresh and mineral-driven profile.
- **Aging potential:** 3 to 5 years under good storage conditions.



Food Pairing

- **Recommended Pairings:** Ideal with seafood, grilled fish, white meats, risotto, and fresh cheeses.



Sustainable Practices and Certifications

- **Sustainable Winemaking:** part of the Boisset Collection, which promotes wines produced in harmony with the land and a long-term commitment to terroir and environmental responsibility.

Producer's Notes

Bourgogne Chardonnay “Les Ursulines” reflects the house’s contemporary approach to Burgundy, combining fruit from multiple terroirs to create a balanced and expressive wine. Produced in the historic Ursulines winery in Nuits-Saint-Georges, it emphasizes purity, freshness, and a restrained use of oak, resulting in a refined and approachable style.

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
