

Town of Baldwin, Maine SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, APRIL 21, 2020, 6:30 P.M.



REMOTE MEETING VIA ZOOM

Note: This meeting was recorded and can be viewed on the website www.baldwinmaine.org. Attendance: Selectmen: Dwight Warren, Jim Dolloff and Gerry Brown as well as members of the Public.

- 1. Selectmen Meeting was called to order approximately at 6:30 PM by Jim Dolloff.
- 2. Review/ Approve warrant
 Gerry Brown requested a motion to accept and approve April 21st, 2020 warrant. Dwight Warren seconded the motion; Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve the warrant.
- 3. Review/ Approve meeting minutes
 Gerry Brown requested a motion to accept and approve April 7th, 2020 meeting minutes. Dwight Warren seconded the motion; Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve meeting minutes.

Old Business

- <u>CIA Salvage</u>: Selectmen discussed getting the CIA dumpster. \$45 per ton for metal and will deduct the plastic. CIA does not charge a haul fee. Selectmen decided to order the dumpster and get it loaded as soon as it gets deliviered to eliminate the chance of trash being put in the dumpster.
- Barking Dog Issue: Wes has a letter written to John Emmons. Wes requested for Selectmen to review. He will send certified mail. The letter is addressing the Animal Control's concern of the barking dog. Wes went and spoke to John Emmons and communicated that something needed to be done with the problem. Will also make contact with Jay Banks. May need to get Town attorney involved.
- Bob Flint Appointment Papers: Selectmen discussed and they will sign Bob's appointment papers.
 Bob is appointed on the Planning Board as an alternate for a 4 year term. Selectmen voted to sign his appointment papers.

New Business

- Rocco Leo tax payments: Rocco contacted the Selectmen's office to ask for a month extension
 with regards to the tax payment arrangement. Selectmen discussed and voted to give him a 30day extension due to the current circumstances.
- <u>Wellness Checks:</u> Kenneth Strout is still living in his home by himself. The state aid is no longer coming due to the Covid pandemic. Will get in touch with Maurice on his recommendations on the situation.
