# "Dwelling in God's House"

Psalm 15 How does God describe those that dwell in His house?

## I. What kind of people are welcome in God's house for worship?

**Psalm 15:1** — "<sup>1</sup> O Lord, who may abide in Your tent? Who may dwell on Your holy hill?

A. It concerns us all to put this question to ourselves -

- 1. <u>By description:</u> "Lord, What kind of people are those whom thou wilt own and crown with distinguishing and everlasting favors?"
  - a. *Matthew 7:14* "For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it.

#### B. God tells us three things this person will not do: v3

**Psalm 15:3** "He does not slander with his tongue, Nor does evil to his neighbor, Nor takes up a reproach against his friend;

- 2. He does not wrong his fellow man.
- 3. He does not keep a list of wrongs against His friends.
- C. God is pleased with the Values of this person: v4

**Psalm 15:4** — "In whose eyes a reprobate is despised, But who honors those who fear the Lord; He swears to his own hurt and does not change;"

- He despises the reprobates -- Reprobate describes a person as divinely disapproved, rejected and condemned to punishment because of his wickedness (cf. Ge 6:3); Pr 29:1; Je 6:30; Ro 9:22; 2 Th 2:10–12.
- 2. He honors those who fear the Lord; He speaks well of those who love and serve God.
- **3.** He values his word and commitment He swears to his own hurt and does not change;

#### 4. He is free from the love of money -v5

**Psalm 15:5** — " He does not put out his money at interest, Nor does he take a bribe against the innocent.

- See the consequence of those that love money -1 Tim 6:10

- **III. God pronounces His blessing over him: v6c "...** He who does these things will never be shaken."
