Early in my ministry at Mt. Hermon, I introduced a concept of centering ourselves around prayer for one minute each day. The

verse we used was John 6:35. During Covid, it was an intentional time to connect and have a devotional time together. After 4 years of nightly devotions, I took a time to abide. Abiding is a time to intentionally step back and assess the ministry which was used to connect us as people of God when we could not gather in person. I missed our intentional time together and I heard from many of you that you missed the time together too. After just two days of beginning the devotions again, more than 300 people have watched the devotions from Sunday evening! Abiding has proven that we have missed our time together.

Luke wrote in Acts 17, ²² Then Paul stood in front of the Areopagus and said, "Athenians, I see how extremely spiritual you are in every way…" Disciples of Christ who call Mt. Hermon "home," I know and have continually seen how extremely spiritual you are too! We will continue the devotions and ask for God's blessings as we continue this ministry of putting His word on social media through our FaceBook page.

Spiritual Seekers – we have many opportunities for you to increase you spiritual journey: Sunday morning worship, sunday school, bi-monthly mid-week worship, reading with us through the new testament. VBS has been a blessing to me as we learned together about the sources used by the writers of the gospels, a brief entrance into the thoughts of the writer of the gospel of John, the words of different translations of bibles, the woman at the well, and then the calling for our lights to continue to shine in the world!

2. Time and Talent Sheet Update - Diane Boulware is compiling the information from the Time and Talent sheets and will disseminate the information when she's done. Pastor Gina will do another round of sheets during VBS to try to get responses from as many people as possible.

3. Cemetery Letter Update – A letter was sent to a family who has a grave that is not marked. A family member contacted Pastor Gina saying that the marker has been ordered and the work will be completed by July 1.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Support Team: Parsonage Vacant and Rate Recommendation – The previous renter moved out in April 2024. Ben Bernstein, a student at the seminary who is a previous recipient of the Stephen Price Scholarship, is moving back to Columbia to complete his degree after doing his internship in New Mexico. He and his wife and child are possible candidates for renting the parsonage. The Support Team recommends that we increase the rental fee from \$900 per month to \$1,200 per month. This will cover the taxes on the parsonage. **PASSED unanimously**.
