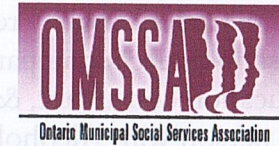

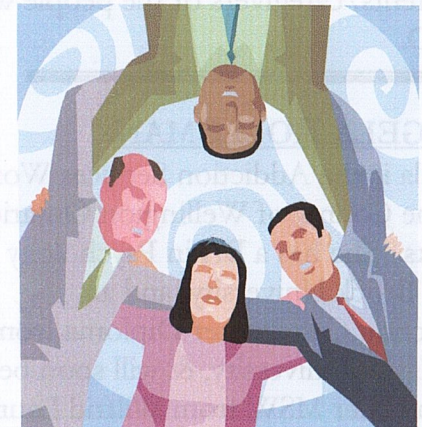
From Hamilton:

She is a retired secondary school teacher, department head & education consultant, & a parent of a young person with Alcohol Related Neurodevelopmental Disorder (ARND). She is the co-founder of the Ontario Coalition for Mandatory Parenting Education (OCMPE) and a co-author of Parenting in Canada.

She has written extensively on FASD issues and currently presents proactive FASD information seminars to front-line workers, educators, justice professionals & parents/caregivers of the people with FASD.

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## ANGELA ROLLEMAN

Angela is the Addiction Services Worker for the County of Wellington Ontario Works. She has a BA in Psychology from Brock University, and an Addiction Caseworker Diploma from McMaster University, & will soon be finished her MSW from Wilfrid Laurier University.
