Happy July!

Wishing you a very happy, healthy, and safe 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday! Please note, the center is closed Monday, July 4 in observance of the holiday.

There is much activity happening at the Center! Congregate lunches are a very popular spot for enjoying great food and fellowship, with growing, regular attendance. We serve Monday — Friday at 11:30 am. Please RSVP if you would like to join us.

Our home delivered meals and transportation programs are also very busy in these summer months. We have seen an increase in the need for services. We now serve more than 470 people on the programs, driving more than 12,956 miles in the month of May. We have served over 40,600 meals this year (4475 more that last year)! (see p12)

With the increase in costs of foods and gas, we will host fundraisers to help offset some of the additional expenses. The first is "Red, White, and Dance" on Friday, July 22, 4–7 pm. <u>Tickets are now on sale for \$10 per person</u>. #### **Supportive Services**


Assistance with completing paperwork related to Medicare & Medicaid, HEAP and Commodities.




