Warning signs of near vision performance problems:

Fusion

- Covering or closing an eye when reading
- Academic performance dropping as the school year progresses in classe that require reading
- Increased frustration with sustained close work

Focusing

- Increasingly avoiding close work activities
- Increase in headaches with sustained reading
- Rubs eyes frequently
- Says eyes are tired after school

Tracking (fixation)

- Skips little words or substitutes words when reading orally
- Moves head excessively when reading
- Uses finger to keep place while reading (especially after 3rd grade
