Conformation 50%; performance, soundness, manners and way of going, 50%. Two or more ponies than the number of ribbons awarded are to be stripped for conformation. Adult or Junior may ride.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Pre-entries can be made electronically at www.horseshowing.com, by email, or phone (908)-534-8833. Entries close at 9:00 pm the evening before the show day. Please no same day, walk-in entries.
2. **Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.**
3. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
4. The Wyndor Farm Horse Show, Briarwood Farms Inc., Katie Benson, the Horse Show Committee or property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
5. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referenced to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
6. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
7. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued.
8. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class (es) or schooling deemed necessary.
9. Ties for first place will be jumped off, all others will remain tied receiving equal points, ribbons and prizemoney.
10. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times mounted on the showgrounds. Masks or face coverings must be worn by all persons unless mounted on a horse.
11. Prizemoney and Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office.
12. All pets must be leashed.
13. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
14. Jump orders will be constructed at the discretion of the show management by the steward.
15. A processing fee of \$40.00 will be made for all non-negotiable checks. Any returned checks not "made good" within 10 days will be forwarded to the USEF for collection per USEF Rules.
16. **MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule
18. Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
