## 2019 TAPPAN HILL BPCR Inc. RANGE SAFETY RULES

1. All members must be able to present their current Tappan Hill membership ID, while at the range.
2. All members and guests must log "in and out" on the Range Activity Log during a nonevent visit, and can legally possess or handle any firearm.
3. Observe and follow all NRA firearms safety rules.
4. All firearms must have actions open with OBI, until called to the firing line.
5. All firearms must be off the firing line and placed in the gun rack, when anyone is down range.
6. Red Range Safety Light, is to be turned on, when anyone is down range.
7. **All Steel Animal Silhouette Targets are for low velocity lead bullets ONLY!**
8. **High Power Centerfire caliber velocities cannot be over 2900 FPS and fired only at approved AR500 steel Gongs and/or established Target Boards.**
9. All approved targets and/or Gongs, must be placed in front of the berms with clear path to berm.
10. **Belted Magnum and Super Velocity calibers over 2900 FPS are prohibited.**
11. FMJ standard velocity ammo can **ONLY** be fired at the established target boards, placed in front of the berms. (Armor piercing, incendiary rounds or Tannerite are **NOT** allowed).
12. Members are permitted to bring their immediate household family to the range.
13. Guests are allowed 2 range visits with paid member then encouraged to join.
14. Guests interested in joining our Tappan Hill Gun Club, must be sponsored by a Senior Member before being approved.
15. Sponsors, accept full responsibly of their new member to follow all Range Rules.
16. All members must immediately report any damage to any Range Officer.
17. Pull all targets and lay flat on the berm rails or storage pallets, to deter road shots.
18. Pick up any trash or litter before leaving the range.
19. Secure and lock all doors and gates prior to leaving the range.
20. With prior notification from our landowner, our range may periodically, be closed for field maintenance. "Closed for Maintenance" sign will be posted at the gate.
