## 1. ELIGIBILITY

This tournament is for Adult Women Members of the Appomattox River USBC.

## 2. EVENTS \& HANDICAP

This tournament will consist of the following events:
A. Doubles Handicap, B. Doubles Scratch
C. Singles HDCP, D. Singles Scratch, E. Singles-Senior HDCP, F. All-Events Handicap, AE-Scratch Events, AE Senior HDCP
NOTE: EVENTS B-D - E-F are all optional
The tournament shall be handicapped at $90 \%$ of the difference between the bowler's average and 220 based on the three (3) game handicap method for tournaments.

## 3. AVERAGE REQUIREMENTS

Entrants shall use highest USBC Certified League average in the following order:
A. 2021/22 USBC Composite Average
B. Current ARUSBC league as of January 1, 2023
C. Bowlers who do not meet any of the above requirements, will be entered with a 220 average.

USBC Rule 310a(2), 319d and 319e WILL NOT apply to this tournament. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of her average. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify scores, if submitted average is lower than corrected average. Corrections in averages can be made up to the completion of the first game of the series, or within 48 hrs after completion of the series if the Tournament Manager has given written consent to the bowler for extension of time to correct her average. See USBC Rule 319a(3).

## 4. PARTICIPATION

Pacers will NOT be permitted in any tournament event.
Doubles \& Singles Events Bowlers may enter and bowl one time in Doubles \& Singles. Bowlers must enter both events. These events are bowled consecutively with the Doubles being bowled first. Senior aged (50+) bowlers may enter the Senior Optional Events. (E \& F)
All-Events: Bowlers participating in Doubles \& Singles may enter in any/all of the offered All-Events Handicap, Scratch \& if eligible, Senior.

## 5. SUBSTITUES

Substitutes are permitted. The sub's name, USBC ID\#, average, plus the name of the bowler being replaced, shall be given in writing to the tournament office no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time of bowling. No player shall change position in any doubles lineup after the player has been checked onto the lanes to bowl, unless authorized by the tournament official in charge.

Subs will be eligible for an All-Events cash prizes only if she subs in Doubles \& Singles for the SAME BOWLER and the bowler being replaced has paid All-Events. Subs will NOT be required to reimburse the original entrant for entry fees paid nor are they expected to give any prize money won to the original entrant.

Substitutes made during a Game or Series will be permitted in accordance with USBC Rule 324b.

## 6. TARDY BOWLERS

Individuals arriving late shall begin play and scores shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Entrants will receive a ZERO for all frames missed.

## 7. PRIZES \& AWARDS

Prize money will be returned $100 \%$ on a handicap basis for each event. The ratio will be at least 1 prize for every five (5) entries or major fraction thereof for each event bowled.

Prize money will be distributed to Team Captains, who will in turn distribute checks. Checks should be cashed within 90 days of date on check.

Final Prize List: The Final Prize List will be posted to the ARUSBC Web Site www.arusbcbowling.com

The ARUSBC will present the following special awards for:

- ARUSBC Tournament Champion Emblem \& Certificate
- Cash prize for: Tournament. High Game \& Series

8. PROTEST affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Manager before the prize payments are made. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tourn Manager within 24 hours of the time bowled. Under NO
CIRCUMSTANCES will games involved in a protest be re-bowled. USBC Rule 329a.

## 9. INTERRUPTED GAMES

If equipment failure on a pair of lanes would delay the progress, T Mgr may authorize moving participants to another pair of lanes. Participants will be granted a 2-ball practice on each lane prior to resuming the game in progress. The interrupted game must then be resumed from the point of interruption.

## 10. TIES \& PLAY-OFFS

In the event of a tie for first place position, Co-Champions will be declared. Duplicate recognition items will be presented. Prize money for the tied position shall be added together and divided equally.

## 11. PROPER ATTIRE

Shirts or blouses must have sleeves, no midriff showing and no obscene wording. Trousers, skirts or shorts must come at least halfway to knee with no rips or holes. Tournament Management will have final say as to proper attire. Bowlers will not be permitted to participate until dressed in proper attire.

## 12. MISC.

- Service Charge for any/all Returned checks... \$25.00
- Lanes are assigned by tournament management.
- Tele-scores will be the official scores.
- Use of flash cameras WILL NOT be allowed.
- Participation in any gambling/money schemes during bowling is prohibited.
- Brackets will be conducted by the ARUSBC only.


## 13. ANY RULES OR REGULATIONS NOT COVERED

ABOVE, SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE ARUSBC TOURNAMENT MANAGER AND TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE USBC TOURNAMENT PLAYING RULES
