Wednesday's Schedule:

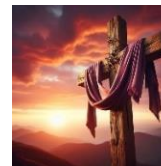
Confirmation is at 5:30 PM.

The Elders meeting is at 8:00 PM.

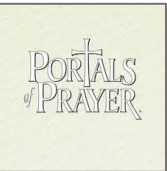


Other TLC News
