Psalm 34

Of David, when he feigned insanity before Avimelech, who drove him away, and he went out.

^{1 (2)} I will make a blessing ^{BRACHA} of praise unto **Yahweh** at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

> ² ⁽³⁾ My soul shall make its boast in **Yahweh**; the humble ^{ANAVIM} shall hear thereof, and be glad.

> > ^{3 (4)} O magnify **Yahweh** with me, and let us exalt His name together.

⁴ ⁽⁵⁾ I sought **Yahweh**, and He heard me, and **delivered** me from all my fears.

⁵ (6) They looked unto Him, and were radiant; and their faces were not ashamed.

^{6 (7)} The poor man cried, and **Yahweh** heard him, and **saved** him out of all his troubles.

^{7 (8)} The messenger ^{MALACH} of **Yahweh** encamps round about them that fear Him, and **delivers** them.

⁸ ⁽⁹⁾ O taste and see that **Yahweh** is **TOV** ^{good}; blessed ^{ASHREI} is the man that taketh refuge in Him.

⁹ (10) O fear **Yahweh**, ye His saints ^{KEDOSHIM}; for there is no lack to them that fear Him.

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^{10 (11)} The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger; but they that seek **Yahweh** shall not lack any **TOV** ^{good} thing.

^{11 (12)} Come, ye children, pay heed unto me;I will teach you the fear of **Yahweh**.

^{12 (13)} What man ^{ISH} is he that desires life ^{CHAYYIM}, and loveth many days, that he may see **TOV** ^{good}?

> ¹³ (¹⁴) Keep thy tongue from **RAH** ^{evil}, and thy lips from speaking guile ^{MIRMAH}.

^{14 (15)} Depart from RAH ^{evil} and do TOV ^{good}; seek SHALOM ^{peace} and **pursue** it.

^{15 (16)} The eyes of **Yahweh** are upon the **TZADDIQIM** innocent, and <u>His ears open to their cry</u>.

^{16 (17)} The face of **Yahweh** is against them that do **RAH** ^{evil}, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.

^{17 (18)} The **TZADDIQIM** ^{innocent} cry, and **Yahweh** hears, and **delivers** them out of all their troubles.

^{18 (19)} Yahweh is near unto them whose heart is broken; and saves such whose spirit ^{ruach} is contrite.

^{19 (20)} Many are the afflictions of the **TZADDIQ** ^{innocent}; but **Yahweh** delivers him out of them all.

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^{20 (21)} He keeps guard over all his bones; not one of them is broken.

^{21 (22)} Evil shall slay the evil ^{resha'im}; and they that hate the **TZADDIQ** ^{innocent} shall be desolate.

^{22 (23)} **Yahweh** redeems the soul of His servants; and none of them that take refuge in Him shall be condemned.
