1. Discuss the clinical features of Otitis media in relation to pathophysiological aspects. Explain the nurse's role in management and prevention of complications of otitis media
2. A client is brought to the casualty with multiple traumas. He is in altered sensorium and has noisy breathing. He is shifted to ICU for ventilator support after an oral intubation
 - a) Discuss the responsibilities of the nurse in ICU with regard to physical examination, physiological monitoring and investigations in caring for this client.
 - b) Write a nursing care plan based on priority and needs for the client with multiple trauma
3. Discuss the predisposing factors and clinical features of cancer stomach. Describe the post-operative nursing care of a client who has undergone partial gastrectomy as a treatment of adenocarcinoma of lesser curvature of the stomach
