

# Breeders Challenge

## Q & A

- You must enter 1 Elite Race to run in the Breeders Challenge Qualifier.
  - You DO NOT have to enter every race offered to match one another.
  - You CAN enter any race Elite offers and also enter any race your horse is eligible for for Breeders Challenge.
  - You CAN enter as many races as you choose to so long as 1 Elite Race has been entered.
  - Times from the Futurity & Derby can be rolled over to the Open Breeders Challenge 4D &/or Elite 5D.
  - You cannot rollover times from the Open Breeders Challenge 4D &/or Elite 5D to the Futurity & Derby.
- Open Futurity, Amateur Futurity, & Derby Horses will run in conjunction with the Elite Futurity & Derby.
  - We do not have a finals in the qualifier, we pay on the aggregate of the two gos. This is different from the Elite Futurity & Derby. The rules applicable to each race will apply.
  - If your Derby horse is aged out of the Elite Derby (8 year olds), you will still run in that race for the Breeders Challenge purse/qualification.
  - At time of checkin, you must declare if you will rollover your times from the 1st & 2nd go of the Futurity or Derby to the Open D Races.
  - 1st go will rollover to Race 1 & 2nd go will rollover to Race 2.
