Owen Feltham

“To trust God when we have securities in our iron chest is easy, but not thank-worthy; but to depend on him for what we cannot see, as it is more hard for man to do, so it is more acceptable to God. “

Born: 1602

Feltham was a chaplain while in the household of the Earl of Thomond in the Peerage of Ireland. Mostly known for being an English author of 146 short essays with great popularity in its day. His most cited essay is “How the Distempers of these Times should affect Wise Men.” Some of his writings evolved into a dissecting three tiered presentation of the middle-class English life; divine, ethical and political. Many of Feltham’s writings are still available today and available in the public domain category.
