We had 64 adoptions in March, bringing our total of adopted County animals to 6,325 since 10/27/2007 when we opened!

In fact, in less than two years, our spay neuter program has 'fixed' almost 1,000 dogs and cats. This program is open to the public for their dogs and cats, too. We received a number of donations toward our fundraising program to replace 50 dogs beds, and we are so thrilled by your generosity! Very soon, as we assemble the beds, you will see them appear first in the pens next to our main building.
