

DON'T FORGET YOUR 2ND APPLICATION OF MERIT GRUB CONTROL

The Japanese beetles have laid their eggs and they will start hatching in late August. The best defense is to stop them before they have an opportunity to grow. Spread Award with Merit Grub control on your lawn. As the larvae emerge from the eggs the pests have the least amount of resistance to pesticides. The new grubs will start feeding on plant and lawn roots. Merit attacks the central nervous system of the grub, causing paralysis and death. Remember, if you get rid of the grubs, you also cut off the food supply to the moles. This application can help prevent mole issues in the spring!



WINTERIZE YOUR LAWN

Delong 24-0-12 Turf Food blend makes an excellent Winterizer for your Lawn when applied in September or October. Use with established lawns; apply when lawn is dry and water following application. For newly seeded grass, use 20-12-8 Lawn Starter Fertilizer.

Fall Applications:

This product can also be applied in the late summer through early fall (late August through November) at use rates from 250 to 500 pounds per acre to provide control of crabgrass through the early part of the next spring. Fall application of this product may be followed by an appropriately timed application in the following spring for season-long control of crabgrass.

Food Plot 101: Cool Temperature, Green Forage

It is not too late to plant your food plot; Austrian Winter Peas can be planted through September and will germinate in temperatures as low as 41° F.

- Strong nitrogen fixer and very high biomass potential
- Quick growth good for weed suppression
- Emergence Time – 9 Days
- Excellent option to plant with cereal grain
- 28% Crude Protein
- Winter hardy to around 0° F

Austrian Winter peas cover crop legume are a rapid, low growing annual legume used across the country as a legume fixing cover crop and/or a quickly decomposing green manure crop. The forage value of winter peas, along with their overall management, are benefited when planted alongside a cereal grain, such as Winter Rye or Oats.

Guardian® Winter Rye is an upright, cool season annual grass that germinates in cool conditions. Also known as “fall” or “cereal” rye, very few species offer the many benefits as winter rye while allowing extended planting flexibility long into the fall. Guardian® is an excellent choice for a low-risk entry into cover cropping. Ideal pH = 5.0-7.0, can be planted into mid-October. This Rye offers the advantage of being the easiest cereal grain to establish in poor soils and having the greatest cold tolerance. Rye offers the greatest production for hay or pasture ground because of its quick growth both in the fall and spring.

Orion XL ladino clover is excellent for pastures and hay, and is widely adapted to different climates. This variety is known for excellent stolon** development and establishment, and competes well against weeds. Orion XL’s large leaves are highly nutritious. This cover tolerates low pH soils, is easy to establish and provides superior winter hardiness.
