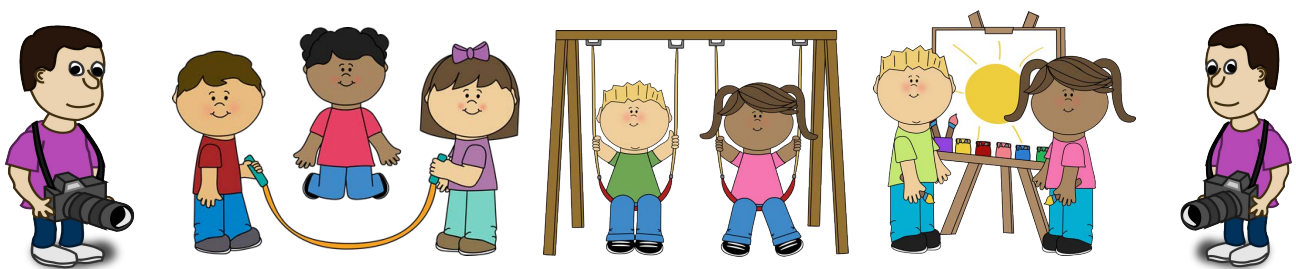

 **Staying Sun Smart
for everyone!** 

Once Term 4 starts, we are back into the summer months, please remember to bring in your child's hat with their name written in it when they attend kinder session, also please remember to put sun-screen on your child either at home or before the session starts at kinder.

The free SunSmart app (www.sunsmart.com.au) tells you when sun protection is recommended for your location and shows current UV levels. Sun protection times can also be found at the Bureau of Meteorology website and live UV levels are also available from ARPANSA .

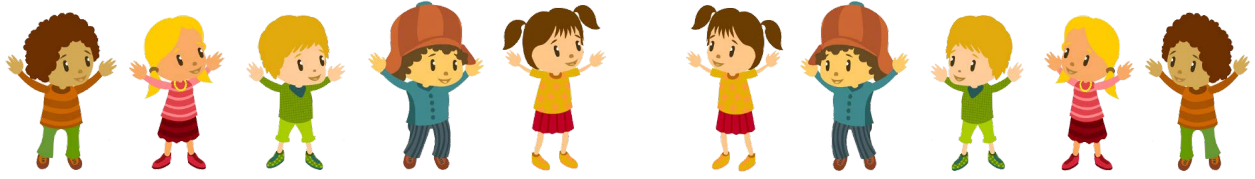
When UV levels are low (typically from May to August in Victoria), sun protection is not recommended unless you work outdoors, are near reflective surfaces (like snow), or outside for extended periods.

Slip, slop, slap and remember the following steps when going outside:

1. Slip on clothing that covers as much skin as possible
2. Slop on sunscreen SPF 30+ broad spectrum screen
3. Slap on a wide brimmed hat that offers shade to your head, face, neck & ears
4. Seek shade and Slide on some wrap around sun glasses



Kinder Groups News



Term 3 & 4 is an exciting and busy term at Greenvue Kindergarten. For our kinder children it is time to get ready for school! During this term, we will be focusing on the children's social and emotional skills as well as building on their language and communication skills along with making them independent. This is beneficial for all the children, both going to school and staying at kinder next year as they have missed so much of the year and they were unable to build their skills in those areas. We have also introduced group learning times where children get to work together in a group then participate in follow-up experiences during the week, as they would do at school. Children are also working with teachers on their individual goals. As always, literacy and numeracy are woven throughout our program and we work on them daily, in various ways.

Another learning focus during this term is on Farm and Jungle animals, in particular learning about their native habitats, what is a baby animal called, etc. The children have been engaging in different experiences based on the same.

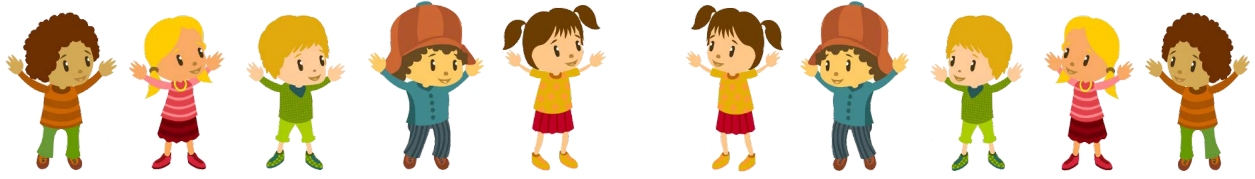
Some interests of the children have been on building, so we have incorporated that into our daily experiences.

Pre Kinder Groups News



Our Pre-Kinder Koala Group have been very busy learning about sea creatures and also attending to our composts in the garden beds. We have been looking after our composts where we added our food scraps into the soil earlier by mixing them with dried leaves, adding worms and watering them regularly to support the composting process. Following the children's voices, we have also been learning some facts about sea animals such as sharks, whales and fish.

During snack time, we have been talking about how to keep our bodies healthy including healthy eating, exercise and the importance of washing our hands. We are excited to continue our gardening journey planting plants in the garden beds that we have been caring for in the warmer weather. Children have been learning about numbers 1-10, shapes, colours and variety of children's songs to support their language skills.

We will be doing a lot of science experiments at parents' request so we are all looking forward to that. We are always open to ideas and requests from our wonderful parents.

At the same time we have been getting them ready for next year's kinder group by working on their confidence, social & emotional skills.

We request children do not wear costumes which are scary; we need to be mindful that some children may be frightened by these. The children will also participate in a parade to show off their costumes at the end of the session!



School Readiness

Readiness for school is in itself an important factor for consideration before starting school, despite the responsive and adaptable programs that schools provide for children and the emphasis upon individualizing learning for each child. Readiness is not about schools just adapting and attempting to meet the needs of children. International research emphasizes that certain areas of development and maturity are essential for children so that once at school, they are able to maximize the opportunities provided.

Social and emotional areas are the key areas of development that are most important for a child in regard to school readiness. This is in contrast to what many people believe - reading, writing and knowing colours or numbers are NOT readiness indicators. Some schools may suggest this is necessary, however this is only a reflection of a particular school's position and not reflective of a child's readiness for school. The key areas of social and emotional maturity related to school readiness can be summarised by reviewing these questions. At kinder does your child

- *Separates easily from parent / carer at drop off ?*
- *Independently makes a decision of where they are going to work / play ?*
- *Self initiates and sustains engagement (6 – 8 minutes), has the skills to solve basic problems and ask for help from the teachers if needed ?*
- *Works and plays besides other children ?*
- *Has basic independence skills (able to put shoes, art smock on, toileting independently) ?*
- *Sits with the group (e.g. during group time) and remains focused, ask questions and answer questions from the teachers ?*
- *Self regulates their emotional responses when they need to do something they don't want to (e.g. don't tantrum when it is time to pack up) ?*

The importance of these skills related to school readiness is highlighted when one imagines a class of twenty school children who do not have these skills. The good news is that most children when they start school have these skills; unfortunately however there will be some children who start school and do not have these skills. This is why making informed decisions about children and school readiness is paramount to giving children the opportunity to thrive and flourishnot just cope.
