Qualifications Overview:

The SDS Yearbook Staff is looking for dedicated, committed, creative, organized, enthusiastic, and innovative students. Staff members must be able to work with others, be reliable, meet deadlines, and put in extra work sessions outside of the regular school day. Staff members must also be dedicated to having fun and creating the best yearbook this school has ever seen!

Because we do not have class time available to work on the yearbook, our projects are driven by our student staffers themselves. We provide cameras and the opportunity for staffers to take photos on campus, and from there it is up to our staffers to put forward ideas and develop projects largely on their own. Staffers can present a concept/draft design, and from there we will work with our students to help them make their ideas into creative yearbook pages! Staffers who do not put forward any ideas will not enjoy the same experience as those who take the initiative and turn their ideas into reality.

We traditionally hold one or two meetings during lunchtime and sometimes after dismissal. But our communication is primarily by email, so please provide a reliable email address below to ensure your student is included.

This year our staff will be smaller than past years so we can focus our work on the most motivated students who have ideas ready to go. Therefore, not all applicants will be accepted. The information you provide in your application will help us determine who to select, so please be thoughtful in your answers and make sure your application is complete and on time, including your teacher evaluation and your signed student/parent commitment form.

1. Applicants must fill out this form and turn it in to Mrs. Langston in the front office **no later than Thursday, August 22, 2019**.
2. Applicants must have the attached teacher recommendation form completed and provided (by the teacher) to Miss Perata no later than August 22, 2019, so please be sure to provide the form to your chosen teacher early, to give them plenty of time!
3. Applicants must have the attached parental forms completed and included with their application.
4. All applicants will receive notification regarding the status of their application by August 27, 2019.
