1) Call to Order and Advance the Colors (Opening Ceremony): (Freeman)

3) Welcoming Guests & Sick Call: (Freeman)

- Veterans attending for the first time were invited to stand and introduce themselves and share their Branch of Service.
- Ray Clemens and Dick Belch have recovered and are no longer on sick call.
- Nominations for the position of Adjutant were opened and the nominating committee, led by Doug Pratt, reported only one nomination for the position of

Adjutant had been received. A motion to accept the nomination of Chris Romig and keep the nominations open until the end of the meeting was approved.

- Special guests were recognized and included:
 - Sara Long, a member of the local scouting troop and nominee for the National Youth Leadership Training Program scholarship, who was sponsored by Post 543.
 - 17 Blue Star families. A history of the Blue Star organization was provided by the Commander and Blue Star flags were presented to families by the Chaplain.

4) Approval of Minutes: (Freeman)

- Minutes of the September 25, 2019 General Membership Meeting were approved without alteration.

5) Membership Report: (Sessa)

- To date 75% of the membership has renewed their membership goal for 2019-2020 and six new members were present for the meeting.

6) Finance Report: (Pratt)

- The monthly finance report showed the Post has received 76% of the budget projections up to this point. Budgeted expenditures totaled 10% and are on track for the year.
- Doug provided a budget update for the 1st Quarter. Due to the tremendous success of the MAD golf tournament, which raised \$5,000 more than projected, the additional funds resulted in budget increases for Veteran Support for Folds of Honor and Wounded Warrior Foundation; Defense for additional ONS Christmas Boxes; Americanism to cover additional Uniforms and Signage; and, Post Operations to cover additional expenses for the new Quarterly News Letter.
- The Finance Report was approved without alteration.

7) Service Officer Report: (Muir)

- Steve reported the state adopted the VEAC as a formal program at the recent Fall Conference. He also reported that, due to the success the American Legion has had in North Carolina in assisting veterans with their claims, the Deputy Undersecretary of the VA would be visiting the Durham office to find out more about their process.
- Steve spoke briefly on benefits provided to Veteran's survivors and made flyers with all applicable information available to everyone.
- Steve provided an update on a wounded Marine at Camp Lejeune and announced the EXCOMM had approved a \$500 donation to the EOD Warrior foundation in his name.
- Steve is working with Rep. Rouzer's local office to assist a veteran in bringing his family from Columbia.

8) Guest Speaker: Sara Busch, Folds of Honor Director of Golf Relations, Southeast United States.

- Since 2007, the Folds of Honor has provided over 24,500 educational scholarships to spouses and children of America's fallen and disabled service-members.

- In 2019 alone, the efforts of our Post, through the MAD Golf Tournament, contributed to the award of 430 scholarships in North Carolina.
- George presented Sara with a check for \$5,000. Sara spoke on the importance of our efforts and expressed deep appreciation and thanks for our support.
