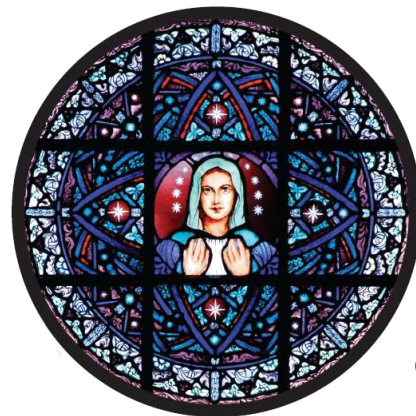

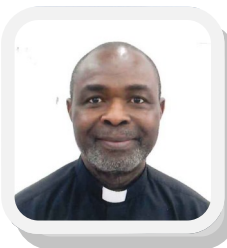

The Fruits of Holy Communion

1391 *Holy Communion augments our union with Christ. The principal fruit of receiving the Eucharist in Holy*

Communion is an intimate union with Christ Jesus. Indeed, the Lord said: "He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him." Life in Christ has its foundation in the Eucharistic banquet: "As the living Father sent me, and I live because of the Father, so he who eats me will live because of me."

On the feasts of the Lord, when the faithful receive the Body of the Son, they proclaim to one another the Good News that the first fruits of life have been given, as when the angel said to Mary Magdalene, "Christ is risen!" Now too are life and resurrection conferred upon whoever receives Christ.

Los frutos de la comunión

1391 *La comunión acrecienta nuestra unión con Cristo. Recibir la Eucaristía en la comunión da como fruto principal la unión íntima con Cristo Jesús. En efecto, el Señor dice: "Quien come mi Carne y bebe mi Sangre habita en mí y yo en él" (Jn 6,56). La vida en Cristo encuentra su fundamento en el banquete eucarístico: "Lo mismo que me ha enviado el Padre, que vive, y yo vivo por el Padre, también el que me coma vivirá por mí" (Jn 6,57):*

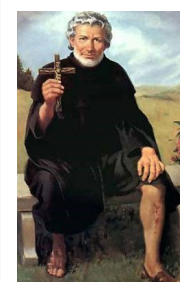

November 6 - Christian Women's Prayer Group in the Chapel.



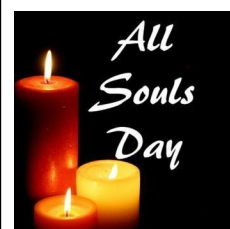
**ALL SOULS DAY
