

# **LEONARD B. FARVER**

## **1925 - 1993**

Leonard B. Farver, 67 and formerly of Elkton, passed away Sunday, Jan. 17 at Memorial Hospital, following a one-year illness. He was a resident of Deming, N.M. for four years.

Mr. Farver was born on Nov. 25, 1925 in Elkton, son of the late Clarence and Lucile (Cox) Farver. He was a bus and truck mechanic. Before moving to Deming, he lived in Carson, CA after leaving Elkton. He was a member of the Holy Family Catholic Church.
