SHEET METAL TECHNICIAN

The Mid-level Technician assists with the inspection, repair, and maintenance of the Navy's Airborne Mine Counter Measures (AMCM) Systems - MK-105 Magnetic Minesweeping Gear. This position repairs sheet metal components from the government's Technical Data Package that includes drawings, specifications, and work instructions to accurately fabricate custom parts. Technicians assist with the set up and operations of all types of sheet metal machinery and hand tools to bend, cut, shape, fit, and assemble metal components. Performs routine mechanical maintenance with specialized sheet metal machinery at the Depot Repair Facility. Must have the ability to drill and rivet thin sheet metal utilizing assembly blueprints while following specific technical requirements for air frame system. Prefer candidates who can demonstrate a past performance with sheet metal sub-assemblies for military or DOD projects. Technical experience shall also include depot maintenance procedures, quality assurance guidelines, hazardous materials precautions and safety requirements. Must be a team player with detailed problem solving skills who can communicate effectively and work well with others.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School graduate or equivalent
- Must have 3-5 years direct experience as a sheet metal technician.
- Must be eligible to obtain security clearance and complete background check.
