DR ROGERS WRITES, "AND WHAT SHOULD OUR THANKS BE FOR? FOR ALL THINGS! THANK GOD FOR YOUR FAITH, FOR YOUR FRIENDS, FOR YOUR FOOD, AND FOR THE WATER YOU DRINK? YOU MAY ASK, "DO I HAVE TO THANK GOD FOR DIRTY DISHES?" WELL, A LOT OF PEOPLE WOULD LIKE TO HAVE DIRTY DISHES; THAT WOULD MEAN THEY HAD SOMETHING TO EAT. BUT ALSO, JUST BE THANKFUL FOR YOUR FORTUNE – THE THINGS THAT GOD HAS GIVEN YOU AND DONE FOR YOU.
