## KGPA COMMUNITY GRANTS PROGRAM

OVERVIEW: The purpose of the KGPA Community Grants Program is to provide assistance to county and regional Kentucky goat associations for local projects that impact goat producers in their community. KGPA will award one grant (per calendar year) up to \$250.00 per year to an applicant for projects that provide education, marketing assistance or increase profitability of Kentucky goat producers.

ELIGIBILITY: Any Kentucky based county or regional goat association is eligible to apply.

SELECTION CRITERIA: The KGPA Community Grants Program is a competitive grant program based on a 100 point system. Points will be awarded as follows:

Explanation of project (25 points)

Scope of project (25 Points)

KGPA Membership (50 points)

Less than 10 KGPA Members – 0 points

10 to 19 KGPA members – 10 points

20 to 29 KGPA members – 20 points

30 to 39 KGPA members - 30 points

40 to 49 KGPA members – 40 points

50 or more KGPA members - 50 points

How to Apply: Complete the application and return to the address below. Applications are taken from April 15-October 15 and one grant is awarded per year.
