



**Mission:**

The mission of the Dual Format Competition is to create a competitive environment that will aid participating programs in the development of their athletes in a cost beneficial manner. The long term vision is for this format to grow the sports fan base, build stronger relationships with neighboring programs and be viewed as a viable cost beneficial alternative to all day events.

**Format:**

The great news is the format is flexible and can be altered depending on program dynamics. The amount formats are unlimited. The initial format used is five teams from each program represent the program. We have done our best to align same level teams to create the fairest most competitive event.

**Example:**

SV will have a Youth 1, Junior 2, Junior 3, Senior 4 (Co-ed), Restricted 5 (Co-ed)

MAC will have a Youth 1, Junior 2, Junior 3, Senior 4 and Restricted 5 (Co-ed)

**Schedule of the Event:**

The event is intended to be a quick hitting event in response to many of our families and industry feedback. The actual teams competing should be completed within an hour. A suggested format would be for athletes to arrive and 1.5 prior to first scheduled competition time. In total and athlete would be there from 2 to 2.5 hours.

**Event Location:**

The event location will be at the Stars Vipers Schertz location and the following year the event will be held at the MAC location. The idea is to have the event at a location to where it is cost effective for both programs.

**Team Registration Fees:**

No fees

**Parking:**

Strongly recommend a location that do not require paid parking

**Door Fees:**

Recommended door fee is \$5 - \$10 dollars. This will depend on the event organizers budget (judges, MC, chairs, etc....)

**Judges:**

We are using a 4-judge panel to derive the score.

- Safety Judge
- Tumbling Judge
- Building Judge
- Overall Judge

All judges should be tenured with strong track records.

**Scoring:**

The scoring will be shared after each team has gone head to head. The scoring will be kept cumulative throughout the competition. The scoring rubric will be the most popular rubric used at the time of the event. The programs can agree on a different rubric if they choose. It is highly recommended to communicate any scoring process to parents and coaches.

**Rosters:**

The intent of these events is to have the organic teams compete. You must strive keep your rosters the same. The practices of having kids substitute, double team or fill in is prohibited. Our goal is to grow kids in their development. If you have roster adjustments, they are encouraged to be discussed prior to the event. Our intent is to keep this a simple process and not have to police program decision making. We will use the honor system at this time.
