- Jeff plays football

Predicate

plays football

- I eat cheese pizza

Predicate

eat cheese pizza

Parts of Predicate

- Predicate

Verb – tells us what action is being done

object – the action is being done with

- Jeff plays football

Verb – plays or playing

Object – football

- I eat cheese pizza

Verb – eat or eating

Object – cheese pizza

Jeff plays football
Sub verb object
S V O = SVO

■ Hindi

Jeff football kheltā hai
sub obj Verb
S O V = SOV

Sub verb object
S V O = SVO

■ Hindi

Maiⁿ cheese pizza khati huⁿ
sub object verb = SOV
S O V
