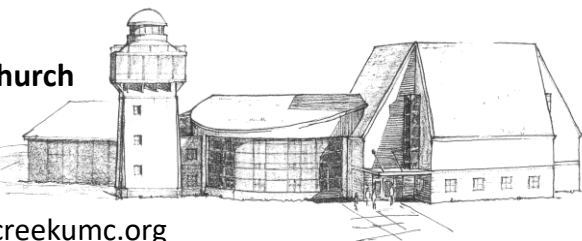
Erie Gives Day 2025
