
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAW ENFORCEMENT ORDINANCE, 1977, ELIMINATING REQUIREMENT OF STATE CERTIFICATION OF TOWN MARSHAL FOR THE TOWN OF MARBLE.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO ORDAINS:


1. Short title. This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Marshal Ordinance, 1980".
2. Certification requirement eliminated. Section 4 of the Law Enforcement Ordinance, 1977, of the Town of Marble, hereby is amended so as to read in its entirety as follows, namely:

The Marshal shall be appointed by the Mayor, and such appointment shall have prior approval of a majority of the Board of Trustees. Other officers shall be selected as deputies by the Marshal, but only if and whenever such selection shall have prior approval of a majority of the Board of Trustees. No person shall be eligible to appointment as Marshal or as a deputy marshal within the Law Enforcement Department unless he be a citizen of the United States; and every such person shall, before entering upon his duties, take and subscribed to an official oath as prescribed by law, and file the same with the Town Clerk.
