

NOTICE AND CALL FOR BIDS:

The ICR Sanitary District is accepting bids for expansion of its wastewater treatment plant at 14000 Grey Bears Trail in Prescott, AZ. The Design of Improvements for Expansion of Wastewater Treatment Plant project covers plans to expand the current treatment plant from an estimated 65,000 gallons per day to a capacity of approximately 90,000 gallons per day. It is estimated that the cost of construction of these improvements will be approximately \$500,000. **Bids will be accepted until 4:00 PM, September 26, 2019.** Bids will be opened at a public meeting of the ICR Sanitary District Governing Board. Bidders will be advised of the date, time and place. Bid documents and the plans, specifications and full information as to the proposed work may be obtained from the District's website: www.icrsd.net or by contacting the project engineering firm, Civiltex Engineering at 928-771-2376.

The District may reject any or all bids for any reason, waive any irregularities or informalities, extend the bid deadline, or postpone the bid opening date. Contractors may propose an alternate to design plans by clearly describing the alternate and including the alternate in the bid. Selection will be made based on the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, considering any proposed alternatives. The District reserves the right to reduce the scope of work or eliminate some items in this contract. The contract for the Work will not be executed by the District until after an objection period has passed and the District Board finds that objections, if any, are without merit. The contract shall be executed immediately thereafter and the Contractor must provide required bonds and insurance within five (5) days after receipt of notice. In the event that the District finds there is merit to the objections, the District may correct any error and/or rebid the Work.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or surety bond for ten percent of the amount of the bid as a guarantee that the successful bidder will enter into a contract to perform the proposal in accordance with the plans and specifications. The conditions and provisions of the surety bid bond regarding the surety's obligations shall follow the following form: Now, therefore, if the obligee accepts the proposal of the principal and the principal enters into a contract with the obligee in accordance with the terms of the proposal and gives the bonds and certificates of insurance as specified in the standard specifications with good and sufficient surety for the faithful performance of the contract and for the prompt payment of labor and materials furnished in the prosecution of the contract, or in the event of the failure of the principal to enter into the contract and give the bonds and certificates of insurance, if the principal pays to the obligee the difference not to exceed the penalty of the bond between the amount specified in the proposal and such larger amount for which the obligee may in good faith contract with another party to perform the work covered by the proposal then this obligation is void. Otherwise it remains in full force and effect provided, however, that this bond is executed pursuant to the provisions of section 34-201, Arizona Revised Statutes, and all liabilities on this bond shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of the section to the extent as if it were copied at length herein.
