

MIDLAND SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- 1. All members of the Midland Services Cooperative and their children are eligible to receive a \$500.00 Scholarship, including employees and directors.
- 2. Applicants may only win a scholarship one time.
- 3. After completing high school, applicants must have completed one semester in an accredited college, university, or technical school. All applicants must currently be a student in good standing.
- 4. Applicants will be judged on leadership, scholastic achievement, extracurricular activities, motivation, and academic and life goals.
- 5. There shall be two scholarships awarded each year.
- 6. Grandchildren of members are not allowed to apply if their parents are not members of the cooperative.
- 7. The selection committee will comprise of appointed community business leaders. Employees and directors of Midland Services shall not serve on the selection committee.
- 8. Applications will be received by March 31st of each year. Awarded recipients will be announced by May 15th of each year.
- 9. Schools receiving application include: Hurley, Ironwood, Mercer, Mellen, Ashland, Drummond, Bayfield, Washburn, Port Wing, Maple, and Superior.
- 10. Recipients will be recognized at the Midland Services annual meeting.
