MIDLAND SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES

1. All members of the Midland Services Cooperative and their children are eligible to receive a \$500.00 Scholarship, including employees and directors.
2. Applicants may only win a scholarship one time.
3. After completing high school, applicants must have completed one semester in an accredited college, university, or technical school. All applicants must currently be a student in good standing.
4. Applicants will be judged on leadership, scholastic achievement, extracurricular activities, motivation, and academic and life goals.
5. There shall be two scholarships awarded each year.
6. Grandchildren of members are not allowed to apply if their parents are not members of the cooperative.
7. The selection committee will comprise of appointed community business leaders. Employees and directors of Midland Services shall not serve on the selection committee.
8. Applications will be received by March 31st of each year. Awarded recipients will be announced by May 15th of each year.
9. Schools receiving application include: Hurley, Ironwood, Mercer, Mellen, Ashland, Drummond, Bayfield, Washburn, Port Wing, Maple, and Superior.
10. Recipients will be recognized at the Midland Services annual meeting.
