The MaxStrong Memorial Fund was established in 2013 in honor of our son Max Salzman, a young man who died on April 24, 2013 of a tragic car accident. Growing up in Norfolk, Max loved sports and was a gifted

athlete. He was the kind of kid who wanted everyone included. Swimming in his back yard pool and at the community pool, he was never too big to play with children who were much younger or didn't have the same abilities. Everyone wanted to hang out with Max, and his big heart had room for them all.

As a living memorial to Max, his family established the MaxStrong Memorial Fund, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit annual giving campaign. The MaxStrong Memorial Golf Tournament supports this fund and helps provide financial assistance to children who need to learn how to swim.

Through the growing support of individuals, companies and foundations within our community and participation in the annual MaxStrong Memorial Golf Tournament, we have been given the opportunity to broaden our mission and increase the number of children who learn how to swim each year. These children participate in swim lessons at our local Norfolk YMCAs. The MaxStrong Memorial Fund makes it possible for any child to learn how to swim and be safe in the water.

YMCA swim lessons teach children water safety, stroke development and rescue skills, reducing the likelihood of drowning and possibly saving a child's life. Max's legacy continues to grow with each lesson and life saved.

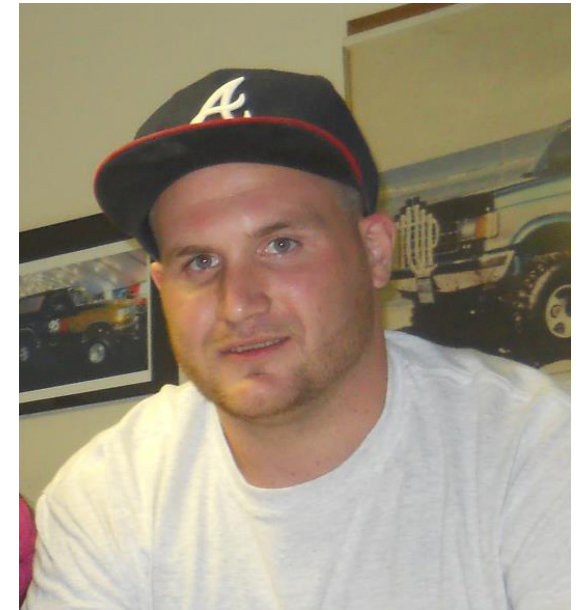
