The ancestors named their farms after the places they came from in the “Old Country” John Thompson Fletcher came from Cherry Valley in Ireland. He cleared 90 acres of land with an axe to create Cherry Valley Farm. This land has natural healing portals which shift as the Poles shift and the earth’s ley lines with them. The area was known as the “walking land” to the Ojibwa who travelled across it. It was also known as sacred land because of the high energies it exudes. Many feel this energy from some distance away. These energies dictated the current use of Cherry Valley as a place of peace and refuge for busy people to come and absorb the tranquility. Workshops to help open spiritual doors are conducted here. Many spirits and ancestors inhabit this place and often show up to enjoy the Workshops.
