

TOWN OF MARBLE
ORDINANCE FOR SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET

A ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO, FOR THE 1991 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Town of Marble has received unanticipated Revenue not assured at the time of the adoption of the budget, and:

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has decided to make needed improvements to the town buildings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO;

Section 1. That the 1991 appropriation for the Park fund is hereby increased from \$745.00 to \$2170.00 for the following purpose: to make necessary improvements to the Town buildings.
