Mildred Maxine Brown, 85 of Bay Port, passed away Sunday, Jan. 15 at the Huron Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe.

Mildred M. Harder was born in Pigeon on Dec. 27, 1909, daughter of the late Nathaniel and Cathrine (Pincumbe) Harder. She was united in marriage on May 12, 1931 to Sanford A. Brown in Pigeon. He preceded her in death on June 26, 1985. Mr. Brown was former Treasurer of the State of Michigan.

Mrs. Brown was a homemaker throughout her lifetime. She was a member of the Bay Port Historical Society and the Bay Port Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, as well as a former volunteer with the American Red Cross while living in Lansing.

Her survivors include her son, Lowell S. Brown, Bay Port; a daughter-in-law, Delphine Brown Collison, Bay Port; eight grandchildren; six great-grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
