

Ordinance Number 715.

-----

An ordinance appropriating certain money's.

Be it ordained by the mayor and Commissioners of the city of Garnett, Kansas,

Section One - that the sum of *nine Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty Six and 48/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of ~~Ewing~~ Tax Fund number (4) in the hands of the city Treasurer to pay the Bills allowed against said Fund in favor of A.L. Cook for final payment for the paving of West Fifth Avenue. which Bills were allowed at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 24th day of September 1917. a list of which may be found on page 74 of the Journal of the proceedings of the board on said date.

Section Two:- that the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Paving Fund Number (5) in the hands of the city Treasurer to pay the Bills allowed against said Fund in favor of A.L. Cook for the final payment for the paving of Main Street from Fourth to Seventh avenue which Bills were allowed at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 24th day of September 1917. a list of which may be found on page \_\_\_\_\_ of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on said Date.

Section ~~Two~~ *Three* :- that the sum of *Two Thousand and No/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Paving Fund Number (6) in the hands of the City Treasurer to pay the bills allowed against said Fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 24th day of September 1917. said bills being for a payment to A.L. Cook on the North Oak Street Paving contract. and the list of said Bills may be found on page 74 of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on said Date.

Section ~~Four~~ *Three* that the mayor and City Clerk be and are hereby authorized and instructed to draw warrants on the City Treasurer to pay the Bills allowed in the foregoing sections of this ordinance.

Section ~~Five~~ *Four* that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Board of Commissioners and its approval by the mayor.
