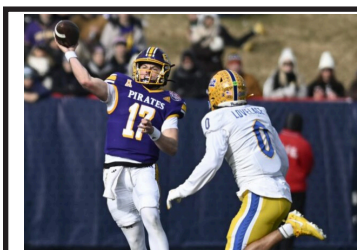

Misleading Finals

East Carolina (+12.5) upset Pittsburgh 23-17. However, Pitt had a 376-249 yard edge but were -4 in turnovers.

Louisiana Tech (-10) beat Coastal Carolina 23-14. However, Coastal had a 356-295 yard edge and actually led 14-3 at halftime. Louisiana Tech outscored them 17-0 in the fourth quarter.

TCU (+4.5) upset USC 30-27 in OT. However, USC had a 392-375 yard edge and led 24-14 with 5 minutes left in the fourth quarter. TCU went 75 yards in 11 plays for a TD, forced a 3 & out and then went 59 yards in 13 plays to get the game-tying FG on the final play. USC settled for a FG in OT and the Horned Frogs got a TD.

Bad Beats

The total in the Toledo/Louisville game was 44. Louisville led 7-3 at halftime and still only led 14-3 entering the fourth quarter but the two teams combined for 32 points in the final 15.

North Texas (-7.5) beat San Diego State 49-47. North Texas led 42-20 entering the fourth quarter. However, San Diego State would rally including scoring a TD with just :01 left on a QB sneak.

Games in Rotation Order

Wednesday, December 31st

Reliaquest Bowl - Raymond James Stadium - Tampa, FL

† **Vanderbilt 25 Iowa 22.** Both teams have been among the most profitable in CFB this year. Vanderbilt is 10-2 ATS with an average cover of 10.6 points per game. Iowa is 8-3-1 ATS with an average cover of 6.1 points per game. Vanderbilt is better in the stats with a +2.1 yards per play margin while Iowa was +0.7. Both played similar strength of schedules. The deciding factor for us is that Iowa should be at full strength for the game while Vanderbilt will be without one of the best TE's in the country in Eli Stowers. Also notable is the Big Ten's 6-1 bowl record so far while the SEC is 2-5 with their only wins coming over another SEC team and vs Tulane at home.

Sun Bowl - Sun Bowl Stadium - El Paso, TX

† **Duke 26 Arizona State 23.** Arizona State was better in the stats with a +0.6 ypp margin while Duke was +0.1. Arizona State will be a shell of themselves in this game with as many as 9 starters out including QB Sam Leavitt, RB Raleek Brown (1,141 rushing yards) and WR Jordyn Tyson (711 yards). Duke will be down three starters including RT Brian Parker, CB Chandler Rivers and DE Vincent Anthony. However, QB Darian Mensah is returning to Duke next season and will play in this game. We bet Duke -1.5 but the line has gone through a key number.

Citrus Bowl - Camping World Stadium - Orlando, FL

† **Texas 27 Michigan 20.** If both teams were at full-strength, this would have been the top non-playoff bowl game. Michigan was better in the stats with a +1.5 ypp margin (Texas (+0.9)). Michigan fired head coach Sherrone Moore and Biff Poggi will serve as the interim. New head coach Kyle Whittingham has been down in Orlando with the team as well the last few days. Michigan was expected to have a ton of opt outs but so far only EDGE Derrick Moore, LB Jaishawn Barham and LG Giovanni El-Hadi have opted out. They did have several injuries at the end of the season and there could be more players out than what's being reported. Texas has been decimated by opt outs. They will be down at least 10 starters including 7 on defense led by S Michael Taaffe, CB Malik Muhammad, LB Anthony Hill and EDGE Trey Moore. They also fired their DC Pete Kwiatkowski but Michigan OC Chip Lindsey is gone on the other side. The UNDER is 20-11 so far this bowl season and that is where our lean is.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Las Vegas Bowl - Allegiant Stadium - Las Vegas, NV

† **Utah 32 Nebraska 19.** This will be Utah's first game without Kyle Whittingham on the sidelines as the head coach or assistant since 1993. DC Morgan Scalley will take over full-time starting with this game but it is expected the Utes will lose several assistants to Whittingham/Michigan. Utah will be depth shy at the line of scrimmage with LT Caleb Lomu, RT Spencer Fano and DE Logan Fano opting out. QB Devon Dampier has said he will play. On the other side, Nebraska is without QB Dylan Raiola who missed the last few games with injury and also their stud RB Emmett Johnson who is off to the NFL. Backup QB TJ Lateef who played the final 3.5 games has been cleared to go here. We lean with Nebraska who has a little more stability.

CFB Playoff Quarterfinal

Cotton Bowl - AT&T Stadium - Arlington, TX

† **Ohio State 24 Miami, FL 14.** These two last faced off in the post-season back in the 2002 National Championship game which saw the Buckeyes shock the Hurricanes 31-24 in 2OT as 11.5-point underdogs. Miami comes in off the impressive 10-3 upset of Texas A&M in the first round. It was their first win on the road vs an AP Top 10 team since 2005. The defense got 7 sacks vs an A&M OL that had only allowed 12 all year. RB Mark Fletcher ran for a season high 172 yards. On the other side, the Buckeyes come in off their first loss of the season vs Indiana that snapped a 16-game win streak (14-1-1 ATS). Ohio State did struggle running the ball vs Texas (77 yards) and Indiana (58 yards), the two best teams they've faced. We expect them to be more aggressive than what they were vs the Hoosiers though as HC Ryan Day will call the plays here. For us, the most trust-worthy unit is the Ohio State defense which ranks No. 1 in ypp, ypg and ppg. They haven't allowed a single team to top 16 points this year. We're not high on Carson Beck's ability to play mistake-free football here.

Thursday, January 1st

CFB Playoff Quarterfinal

Orange Bowl - Hard Rock Stadium - Miami Gardens, FL

† **Oregon 28 Texas Tech 25.** Oregon comes in off the 51-34 win over James Madison which saw their backers get dealt a tough blow after leading 48-13. The Ducks defense allowed a season-high 509 yards and 34 points but the offense looked sharp. Texas Tech is playing in arguably their biggest game in school history. The Red Raiders were a nation-best 12-1 ATS this year but it came against the weakest schedule of any Power 4 conference team (No. 68 in Sagarin, No. 70 in our SOS rankings). This will be the first Top 10 team they've faced this season. Oregon was better in the stats with a +2.9 ypp margin (Texas Tech +2.4) and the Ducks played the much tougher schedule. Oregon games have been a bit misleading as they played a couple in horrific weather (Iowa and Wisconsin) and they were also dealing with cluster injuries at WR. They should get back two starters at WR here. We like the OVER here.

CFB Playoff Quarterfinal

Rose Bowl - Rose Bowl - Pasadena, CA

† **Indiana 27 Alabama 20.** This is the largest underdog role for Alabama in any game since the 2008 SEC Championship. It's a shocking number for many living in SEC country but the reality is Alabama hasn't played like a Top 10 team since October. Even in the Tide's win at Oklahoma in the first round, they were out-gained by 102 yards. Two of their "best" wins this season came against Missouri and Tennessee who combined to beat ZERO teams with a winning record this season. The Alabama offense has run for a combined 25 yards in their last two games. They're facing the No. 3 rushing defense in the country although the Hoosiers did lose DE Stephen Daley who was No. 2 in the country with 19 TFL's. Indiana doesn't have a blue-blood pedigree but the Hoosiers are the superior team in the stats with a +2.5 ypp margin (Alabama +0.9). Indiana has two wins this year vs Top 5 teams in Oregon and Ohio State, both away from home. We bet Indiana -6.5. Keep an eye on the weather as rain is likely (very rare for the Rose Bowl).

CFB Playoff Quarterfinal

Sugar Bowl - Caesars Superdome - New Orleans, LA

† **Georgia 31 Ole Miss 23.** A rematch of a October 18th meeting that saw Georgia win 43-35 as 7.5-point home favorites. Ole Miss led 35-26 entering the fourth quarter but the Bulldogs made the adjustments and outscored them 17-0 in the final 15. Georgia had a 510-351 yard edge in the game. Obviously, Ole Miss will be without HC Lane Kiffin for this game. The Rebels easily won and covered vs Tulane in the first round but they did allow 421 yards on offense. Meanwhile, Georgia's defense is playing as well as any unit in the country down the stretch. They've allowed just 226 yards per game, 7 points per game and 32 rushing yards per game in their last four. Kirby Smart is on a 7-1 straight up run in the post-season with an average win by nearly 20 points per game. Massive edge here vs Pete Golding in his 2nd game as head coach.

Friday, January 2nd

Armed Forces Bowl - Amon G Carter Stadium - Fort Worth, TX

† **Texas State 36 Rice 21.** These two met in a bowl game a couple years ago which saw Texas State win 45-21. Texas State is much better in the stats at +1.0 ypp margin vs Rice's -1.7. Rice did play the tougher schedule. However, the Owls will be playing without starting QB Chase Jenkins here. Texas State should be relatively healthy. The Bobcats were much better than their record as they lost 4 games by a TD or less. We don't think Rice's offense will be able to keep up.

Liberty Bowl - Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium - Memphis, TN

† **Navy 31 Cincinnati 23.** If Cincinnati were fully healthy, they'd likely be favored here. They opened as high as a 6.5-point favorite on the openers. Why are they catching 7 points now? How about they're missing 8 starters including QB Brendan Sorsby and their entire secondary. DT Dontay Corleone and LB Jack Golday both declared for the NFL Draft and neither are on the depth chart. You don't have to worry about motivation issues, the transfer portal, the NFL or any opt outs with the service academies. After Army's blowout win over Connecticut, service academies are on a 19-3 SU and ATS bowl run back to 2013. Usually, Cincinnati missing all 4 starters in the secondary wouldn't be a major issue vs an option attack. However, Navy had their best passing offense in a quarter century this year led by their all-time leading receiver Eli Heidenreich. We bet Navy and still like them even after the big line move.

Mayo Bowl - Bank of America Stadium - Charlotte, NC

† **Mississippi State 28 Wake Forest 25.** Both teams have been hit pretty hard by the transfer portal with Mississippi State missing 24 players (2 starters) and Wake Forest missing 18 (5 starters out). The biggest ones being Wake Forest DT Mateen Ibirogba and RB Demond Claiborne. Wake was better in the stats with a +1.4 ypp margin vs Mississippi State's -0.4. However, the Bulldogs played the much tougher schedule. Mississippi State fired their DC and it looks like Kamario Taylor will get the start at QB. With so much uncertainty, we defer to the power ratings which have Mississippi State by 3.2. Right at the line.

Holiday Bowl - Snapdragon Stadium - San Diego, CA

† **Arizona 27 Smu 25.** A solid matchup here to close out the regular bowl slate. Arizona was slightly better in the stats with a +1.3 ypp margin vs SMU's +1.1. Both played similar strength of schedules. As of press-time (10am Wednesday morning), there has been limited opt outs mentioned but Arizona head coach Brent Brennan said there could be a few. SMU QB Kevin Jennings will play and so will Arizona QB Noah Fifita. Our power ratings call for Arizona to be the slight favorite here and the total to be 52. We don't see much value at current unless you can find a +3 on SMU.

Games in Rotation Order

Saturday, January 3rd

TAMPA BAY 22 Carolina 20. This was supposed to be a winner-take-all battle but the Falcons upset over the Rams on MNF means that Carolina could still win the NFC South division with a loss here (provided Atlanta beats New Orleans on Sunday). Tampa comes in reeling at 1-7 SU and 0-8 ATS in their last 8. They've been favored in 6 of those 8 games. That includes a 23-20 loss at Carolina on December 21st as a 3-point favorite. Both teams are -0.6 in ypp margin. We don't see much value.

Seattle 26 SAN FRANCISCO 24. The winner gets the No. 1 seed in the NFC. If the Seahawks lose, they drop to the No. 5 seed. If the 49ers lose, they could drop to as low as the No. 6 seed (if the Rams beat the Cardinals). They played way back in Week 1 with San Francisco winning 17-13 as 2-point road favorites. Since then, the Seahawks have been the best team in the NFL ranking No. 1 in ypp margin, No. 1 in DVOA and No. 1 in Sagarin. The 49ers are No. 15 in ypp margin, No. 9 in DVOA and No. 6 in Sagarin, hence why they're the home dog here. San Francisco barely survived the Bears on SNF. The week prior they played on MNF so this is their 3rd game in 13 days. Meanwhile, the Seahawks prior to last week played on TNF. This is their 3rd game in 17 days. They're the fresher team in our opinion.

Sunday, January 4th

MINNESOTA 21 Green Bay 14. Green Bay is locked into the No. 7 seed. It is more important for them to keep healthy as they've been decimated by injuries in recent weeks especially on defense. Jordan Love is out and they'll likely go Malik Willis or Clayton Tune at QB. Minnesota has won and covered four straight games and should be motivated to get to a winning record here with a win. They upset the Lions last week with only 161 yards of offense due to a +6 turnover margin (largest in NFL this season). Can you trust Max Brosmer laying a TD? Pass.

HOUSTON 24 Indianapolis 14. Indianapolis has been eliminated from the playoffs. They are the first team since the 1995 Oakland Raiders to start a season 8-2 and miss the post-season. Riley Leonard will be making his first career start here. Houston is likely the No. 5 seed. The Texans are now 11-2 SU and 9-4 ATS since their 0-3 start and have the No. 1 defense. Not much interest.

NEW ENGLAND 28 Miami 16. New England is likely the No. 2 seed (provided Denver wins as a double-digit favorite and gets the No. 1). The Pats destroyed the Jets last week thanks to QB Drake May going 19 of 21 for 256 yards and 5 TD's. New England has played consistent all year no matter the dog or favorite role. The same can't be said for the up-and-down Dolphins who did upset Tampa Bay last week. Early forecast is calling for 25 degrees and light snow. Not good for Miami. Note: New England WR Stefon Diggs faces assault chargers and will likely miss.

Kansas City 20 LAS VEGAS 14. It's clear that Las Vegas wants the No. 1 overall pick (put Crosby on IR) and a loss here would clinch it. Kenny Pickett will get the start at QB for the Raiders. Even though the Chiefs were down to 3rd string QB Chris Oladokun last week, they played the Broncos tough and have a few extra days to prep. KC games are on a 10-1 run to the UNDER. That's where our lean is.

CHICAGO 27 Detroit 24. Since their bye week, Detroit is just 3-6 SU and 2-7 ATS. They've lost each of their last two games as TD-plus favorites. Last week they were -6 in turnovers vs Minnesota and will be sitting at home for the playoffs one year after going 15-2. With a win, the Bears can clinch the No. 2 seed in the NFC and get the Packers at home. That would be much preferred compared to the Rams or 49ers. Chicago is 10-2-2 ATS since Detroit crushed them 52-21 in Week 2. They get revenge.

BUFFALO 22 N.Y. Jets 14. After their last-second 2-point conversion attempt was no good vs the Eagles last week, the Bills were eliminated from winning the AFC East. There's little incentive to play Josh Allen here so we could see Mitch Trubisky. The Jets have been the worst team in football the last month. They've lost 4 straight by 27 ppg and are also 0-4 ATS failing to cover by 18 ppg. Even if Trubisky plays, we lean Buffalo.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Baltimore 20 PITTSBURGH 18. This game got flexed to SNF. Winner take all in the AFC North. Remarkable considering it took a Baltimore upset at Green Bay last Saturday and the Steelers losing outright at Cleveland. Baltimore can thank future Hall of Famer Derrick Henry who ran for 216 yards, the most by a visiting player in Lambeau's history. Meanwhile, Pittsburgh clearly missed WR Dk Metcalf. The Steelers won at Baltimore 27-22 on December 7th as 5.5-point underdogs. This line indicates Lamar Jackson returning for Baltimore. Even if he does play, we like the Steelers catching 3.5.

CINCINNATI 26 Cleveland 18. Neither has much to play for other than pride. Cincinnati comes in off back-to-back blowout wins. Meanwhile, the Browns got an upset win over the Steelers. Myles Garrett still needs one more sack to break the single-season record while it looks like Joe Burrow will start for the Bengals. Not much interest for us other than using Cincy in a teaser.

Dallas 28 N.Y. GIANTS 24. The Cowboys can get to .500 with a win. They have extra time to prep after playing on Christmas Day. Dallas games are on a 10-2-1 run to the OVER while Giants games are on a 9-2 run to the OVER. Both starting QB's are expected to play. We lean OVER.

PHILADELPHIA 24 Washington 17. The two teams just played on December 20th with Philly winning 29-18 as 7-point road favorites. The Eagles need a win and a Bears loss to get the No. 2 seed. It is significant considering the No. 7 seed will be a banged up Green Bay team while the No. 6 seed will be dangerous L.A. Rams or 49ers teams. Philly led Buffalo 13-0 at halftime last week but had to hang on for dear life in the final seconds stopping a 2-point conversion attempt. The Eagles didn't complete a pass in the second half. There's some QB uncertainty here as it looks like Josh Johnson will start for Washington. Could Tanner McKee get the start for the Eagles? The line seems to reflect that.

ATLANTA 24 New Orleans 20. If we're being honest, we'd rather the winner of this game represent the NFC South as opposed to the Bucs/Panthers games. Atlanta has won and covered three straight games. They pulled off a shocker on MNF beating the Rams 27-24 (led 21-0 at halftime). Meanwhile, the Saints have won four straight and covered five straight. Atlanta is ranked higher in ypp, DVOA and Sagarin and that is where our lean is.

L.A. RAMS 26 Arizona 18. It's been a devastating couple of weeks for the Rams. On December 18th, they led the Seahawks 30-14 on the road in the 4Q and were heading towards the No. 1 seed in the NFC. After blowing that game in OT, they lost on MNF to the Falcons by 3 after trailing by 21 at halftime. If San Francisco wins on Saturday, this game means nothing for the Rams and they would be locked into the No. 6 seed and heading to Philadelphia or Chicago. If the Seahawks were to win, this game becomes more important because a win would give the Rams the No. 5 seed and a date at lowly Tampa or Carolina. Arizona is on a 0-8 SU and 1-7 ATS run. Their TE Trey McBride did just set the single-season reception record for TE's. They'll be more concerned for tee times.

DENVER 26 L.A. Chargers 13. Denver will get the No. 1 seed with a win. It is likely considering the Chargers are going to rest their starters and are likely heading towards a No. 7 seed. The look-ahead line was Denver -3 so obviously a lot of this is baked in. Trey Lance will get the start in place of Justin Herbert who needed a break. Not much interest for us.

JACKSONVILLE 29 Tennessee 17. Jacksonville head coach Liam Coen is the first coach in NFL history to inherit a 4-win team and lead them to 12 wins. The Jags have won and covered 7 straight games. They have an outside shot at the No. 1 seed but are most likely getting the No. 3 seed if Denver and New England win (both are double-digit favorites). They still need a win to clinch the division and Trevor Lawrence should start.
